## CATECHISM

### Sermon on the Mount

1965 The New Law or the Law of the Gospel is the perfection here on earth of the divine law, natural and revealed. It is the work of Christ and is expressed particularly in the *Sermon on the Mount*. It is also the work of the Holy Spirit and through him it becomes the interior law of charity: "I will establish a New Covenant with the house of Israel. . . I will put my laws into their minds, and write them on their hearts, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people."

1966 The New Law is the *grace of the Holy Spirit* given to the faithful through faith in Christ. It works through charity; it uses the Sermon on the Mount to teach us what must be done and makes use of the sacraments to give us the grace to do it

1967 The Law of the Gospel "fulfills," refines, surpasses, and leads the Old Law to its perfection. In the Beatitudes, the New Law *fulfills the divine promises* by elevating and orienting them toward the "kingdom of Heaven." It is addressed to those open to accepting this new hope with faith - the poor, the humble, the afflicted, the pure of heart, those persecuted on account of Christ - and so marks out the surprising ways of the Kingdom.

**St. Scholastica** - Monday, February 10

Today's saint was the twin sister of Benedict, founder of the Benedictine Order. She lived in a century and country full of difficulties during the 6th century in central Italy, when armies of Goths and Byzantines crisscrossed the land and repeatedly terrorized the people. Scholastica demonstrated her holiness, peace and strength. Rivaling her brother in holiness. Scholastica died in 547.

**Our Lady of Lourdes** - Tuesday, February 11

This is World Day of Prayer for the Sick.

**St. Cyril & Methodius** - Friday, February 14

These brothers are of great importance as links between the Eastern and Western Churches and as Apostles to the Slav nations. Born around 825 in Greece, they became Byzantine missionaries in Moravia, Bohemia and Bulgaria. Cyril died in Rome in 869. Methodius achieved missionary success as papal legate to the Slav nations and died in 885 in Czechoslovakia.
