St. Martha - Wednesday, July 29

Martha is remembered as the one who was fretting when Jesus came to dinner, in sharp contrast to her sister Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet. Jesus tells Martha that Mary has chosen the "better part." Martha clearly takes Jesus' correction to heart. When he comes to Bethany again, this time because her brother Lazarus has died, Martha is still the active one, the doer. She runs out to greet Jesus while Mary stays at home. But now Martha's anxiety has given way to faith: "I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world."

GIFT OF FAITH

153 When St. Peter confessed that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the loving God, Jesus declared to him that this revelation did not come "from flesh and blood," but from "my Father who is in heaven." *Faith is a gift of God, a supernatural virtue infused by him.* Before this faith can be exercised, man must have the grace of God to move and assist him; he must have the interior helps of the holy spirit, who moves the heart and converts it to God, who opens the eyes of the mind and 'makes it easy for all to accept and believe the truth."

154 Believing is possible only by grace and the interior helps of the Holy Spirit. But it is no less true that believing is an authentically human act. Trusting in God and cleaving to the truths he has revealed are contrary neither to human freedom nor to human reason. Even in human relations it is not contrary to our dignity to believe what other persons tell us about themselves and their intentions or to trust their promises (for example, when a man and a woman marry) to share a communion of life with one another. If this is so, still less is it contrary to our dignity to "yield by faith the full submission of . . . intellect and will to God who reveals," and to share in an interior communion with him.

155 In faith, the human intellect and will cooperate with divine grace: "Believing is an act of the intellect assenting to the divine truth by command of the will moved by God through grace."

St. Ignatius - Friday, July 31

St. Ignatius was born in 1491 at Loyola in Cantabria. He spent his early years at court and as a soldier. Later he was converted to God and undertook theological studies at Parish where he attracted his first followers, and afterward at Rome he joined them together as the first members of the Society of Jesus. . . . He exercised a most fruitful apostolate both by his written works and in the training of his disciples who won great praise for their renewal of the Church. He died at Rome in 1556.

St. Alphonsus - Saturday, August 1

St. Alphonsus Liguori was born at Naples in 1696. Though renowned as a doctor of both Canon and Civil law, he left the legal profession and entered the priesthood. Subsequently he founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. To foster the Christian life, he applied himself to preaching among the people and writing books on moral theology of which he is considered a master. He was chosen bishop of Sant' Agata dei Goti, but soon resigned his office to work with his confreres at Nocera dei Pagani in Campagna. St. Alphonsus died in 1787.
