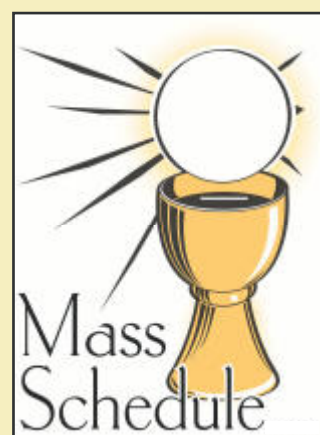

# Church Ministries



## Altar Servers

*"You are blessed to be 'particularly close to Christ Jesus in the Eucharist. You have the enormous privilege of being close to the altar, close to the Lord.'" (Pope Benedict XVI)*

The altar servers at the parish of St. John the Evangelist and Our Lady of Mount Carmel assist the priests at Sunday Mass, weddings, funerals and special liturgies. They are an important and much-appreciated part of our Liturgies. This ministry promotes a closer relationship with the ever-present Body of Christ in the lives of those who serve.

All interested 4th graders and older who wish to serve will be trained. Altar servers can choose the Mass time(s) they prefer. If you are interested in being an altar server please contact the rectory.

## Greeters and Ushers

*"Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, [then] I will enter his house and dine with him, and he with me." (Revelation 3:20)*

Greeters and Ushers perform a valuable function in welcoming persons attending our services. They distribute the Church Bulletin after Mass, help to seat attendees, if necessary, introduce newcomers to other parishioners, pass the collection baskets, seek out Gift Bearers and ensure the orderly flow of persons receiving Communion.

Any enthusiastic and caring adult, teen or family who wishes to serve will be trained. Greeters and Ushers can choose the Mass time(s) they prefer. If you are interested in participating in this ministry, please contact the rectory.

## Eucharistic Ministers

*"They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to breaking of the bread and to the prayers." (Acts 2:42)*

Eucharistic Ministers share the Body and Blood of Christ with those gathered at the celebration of the Mass. Any adult Catholic who has received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation) who wishes to serve will be trained. Eucharistic Ministers can choose the Mass time(s) they prefer. If you are interested in participating in this ministry, please contact the rectory.

## Lectors

*"Until I arrive, attend to the reading, exhortation and teaching." (1 Timothy 4:13)*

The proclamation of the Scriptures is an ancient and important ministry in the Church. Lectors proclaim, with reverence, the Scripture readings and the Prayer of the Faithful at Mass, and read the special announcements after Communion.

Any adult or teen with a clear speaking voice comfortable talking in front of people who wishes to serve will be trained. Lectors can choose the Mass time(s) they prefer. If you are interested in participating in this ministry, please contact the rectory.
