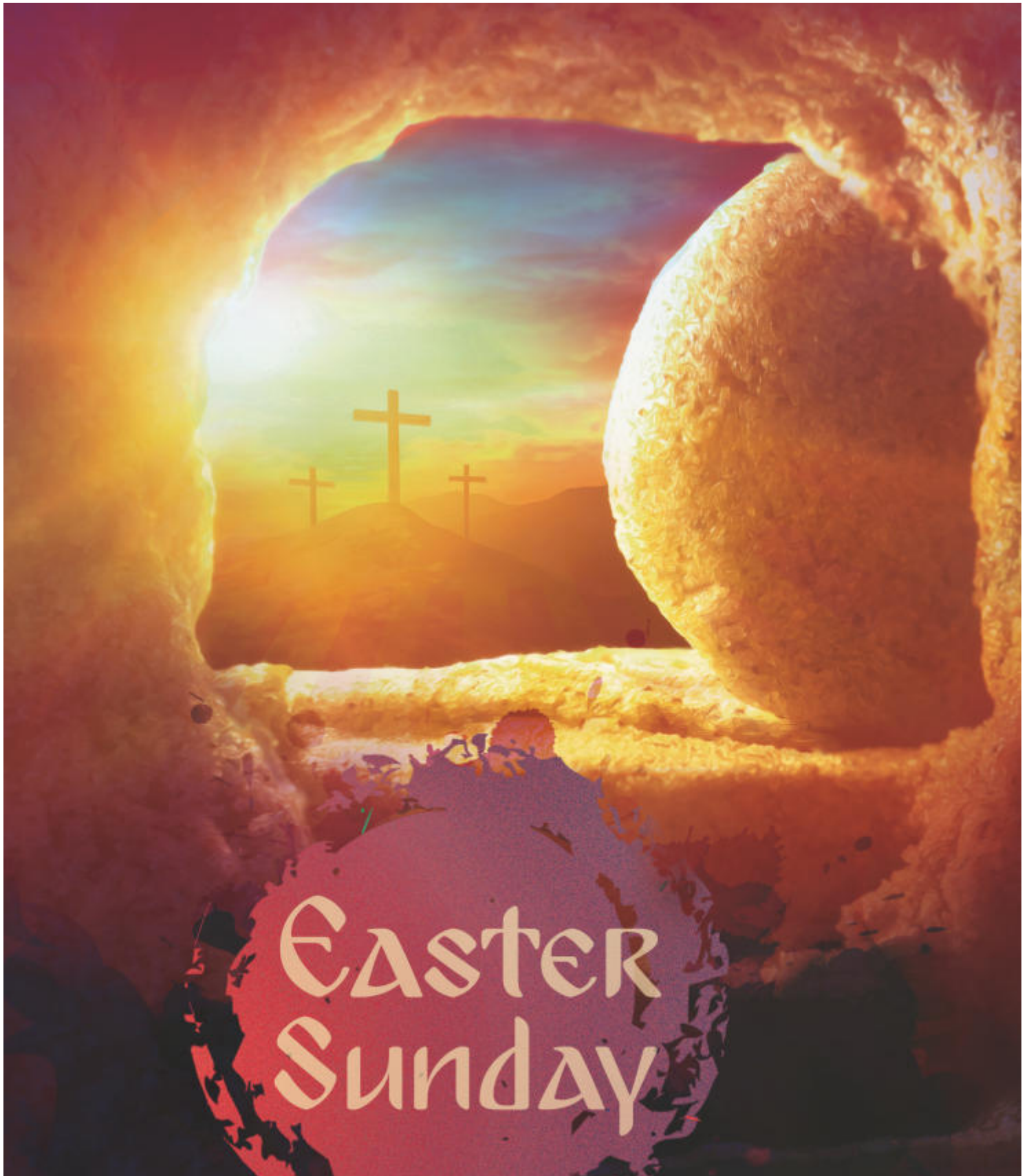

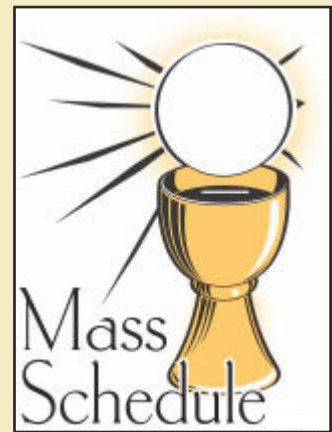

Dear Parishioners,

My favorite song from the powerful musical "The Lion King" is the song titled "He lives in You". To me the lyrics testify to faith in the Resurrection when it sings out loud: "There's no mountain too great; hear the words and have faith. Have faith. He lives in you, He lives in me; He watches over everything we see; into the water; into the truth; in your reflection, He lives in you". At Easter, Jesus wants us to believe and understand that Resurrection is Real. As Saint Paul tells us in 1 Cor. 15: "If Christ did not rise from the dead, all of our preaching and all of our faith would be in vain". Jesus moved from the state of Crucifixion to Resurrection and so must we. Jesus rose and He is alive. The question is when do we rise? Jesus had the expectation that when He rose, we arise too. As followers of Jesus, we have been called to live as his Resurrection people in the belief that He lives in you and me. Therefore, let us have faith that we are the Resurrection, yes, we are the living body of Christ. Inside us, God lives in us, and each one of us is called to be a Lover and Healer of our world. We need to rise up and love each other. We need to rise up and let go of our fears and our prejudices. We need to rise up and proclaim the truth that each one of us is inextricably connected to the other. We must rise up. Can you rise up? Will you rise up? Will you love and make a difference?

Thanks so much for being part of our faith community and for all you do to make our Church more caring, loving and welcoming. Happy Easter!

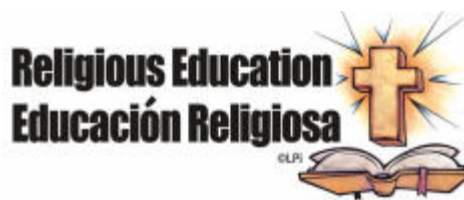

A SIGN OF LOVE

The resurrection of Jesus was a hidden event. Jesus didn't rise from the grave to baffle his opponents, to make a victory statement, or to prove to those who crucified him that he was right after all. Jesus rose as a sign to those who loved him and followed him that God's divine love is stronger than death. To the women and men who committed themselves to him, he revealed that his mission had been fulfilled. To those who shared in his ministry, he gave the sacred task to call all people into the new life within him.

The world didn't take notice. Only those whom he called by name, with whom he broke bread and to whom he spoke words of peace, were aware of what happened. Still, it was this hidden event that freed humanity from the shackles of death.

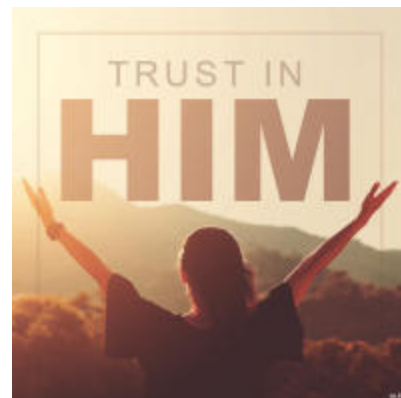
