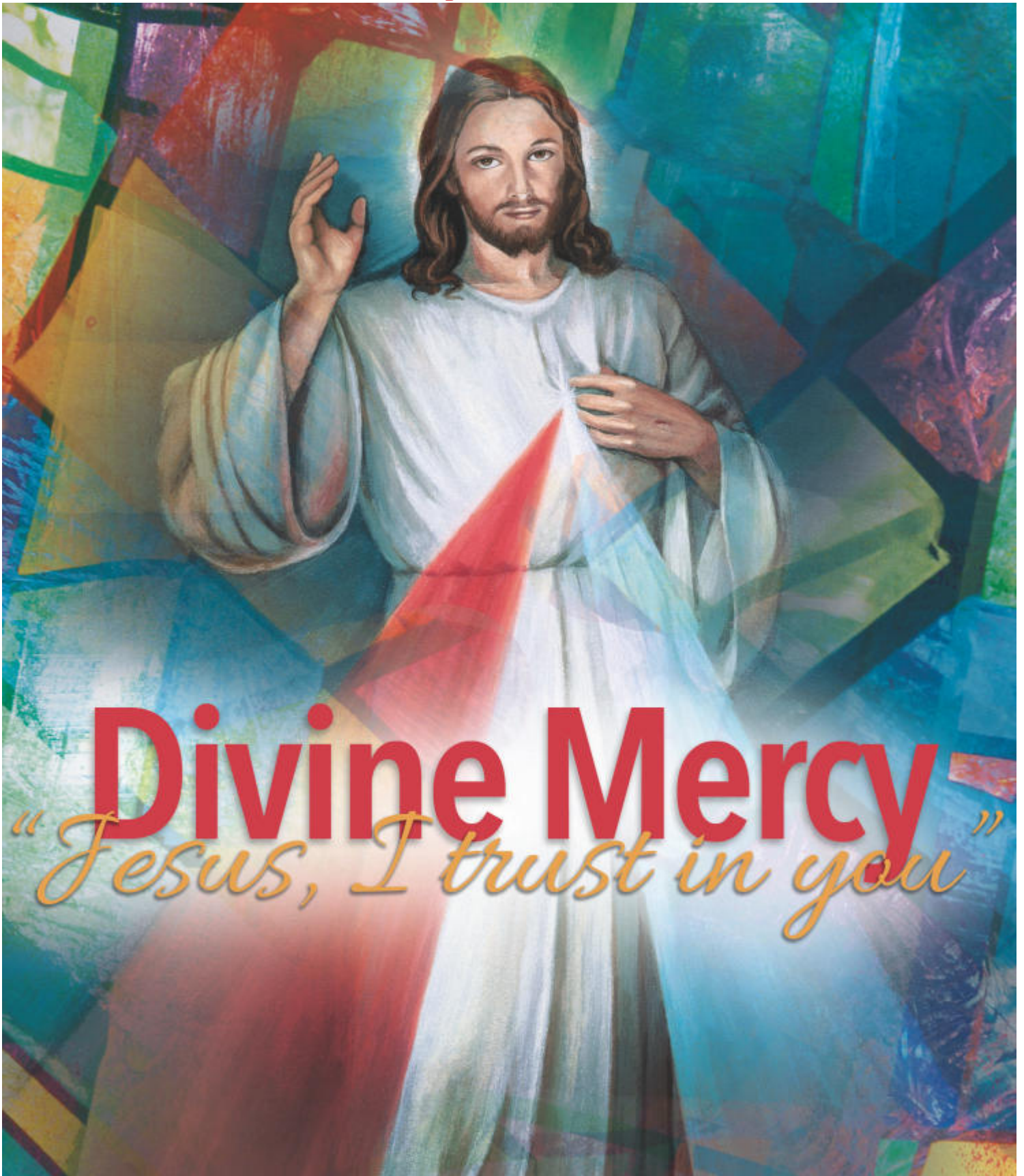

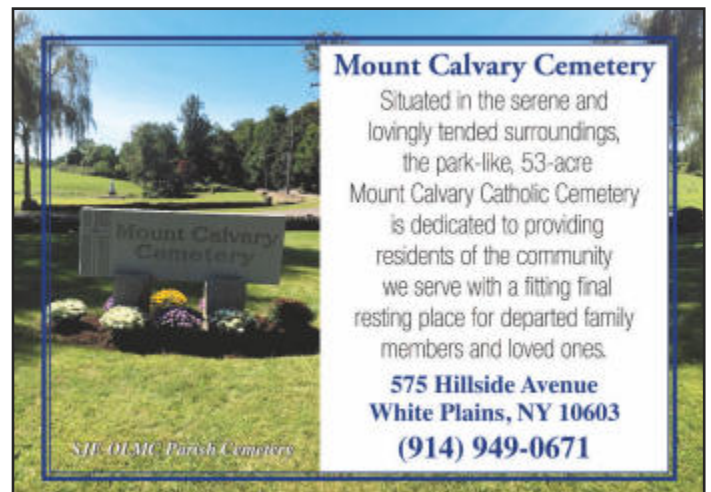

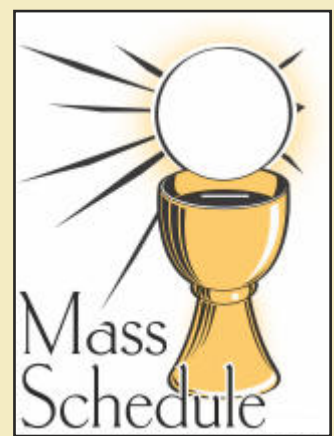

Pope says Mercy is the Answer



Only the mercy of God will quench the thirst of all people, St John Paul II told about 50.000 pilgrims gathered in St. Peter's Square on April 22, 2001, for the first worldwide celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday.

"Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift the Church receives from the Risen Christ and offers to humanity at the dawn of the third millennium," the Holy Father said in his homily. Christ, "who implores forgiveness for His torturers and opens the gates of heaven to repentant sinners," is a reason for hope not only for believers, but also for non-believers, the Pope said.

"In the humiliated and suffering Christ believers and non-believers can admire a surprising solidarity which binds Him to our human condition beyond all imaginable measure," he added.

Jesus' love, which in the Resurrection shows itself stronger than sin and death, "is revealed and put into practice as mercy in our daily lives and prompts every person in turn to have 'mercy' towards the Crucified One," St. John Paul II said.

Later, during his noontime address, the Holy Father gave thanks for the Apostle of Divine Mercy. "During this celebration, together with you, I thanked God who almost one year ago, granted me the grace to canonize Sr. Faustina Kowalska, the chosen apostle of the merciful Christ, and to proclaim the Second Sunday of Easter as the Feast of Divine Mercy for the entire Church."

Papa dice que la Misericordia es la Respuesta



Solo la misericordia de Dios apagará la sed de todas las personas, San Juan Pablo II les dijo al grupo de 50,000 peregrinos reunidos en la Plaza de San Pedro el 22 de abril de 2001, para la primera celebración mundial del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia.

"¡Divina Misericordia! Este es el regalo de Pascua que la Iglesia recibe de Cristo resucitado y ofrece a la humanidad en los albores del tercer milenio ", dijo el Santo Padre en su homilía. Cristo, "que implora el perdón por sus torturadores y abre las puertas del cielo a los pecadores arrepentidos", es un motivo de esperanza no solo para los creyentes, sino también para los no creyentes, dijo el Papa.

"En el Cristo humillado y sufriente, los creyentes y los no creyentes pueden admirar una sorprendente solidaridad que lo une a nuestra condición humana más allá de toda medida imaginable", agregó.

El amor de Jesús, que en la Resurrección se muestra más fuerte que el pecado y la muerte, "se revela y se pone en práctica como misericordia en nuestra vida cotidiana e incita a cada persona a tener" misericordia "hacia el Crucificado", San Juan Pablo dijo.

Más tarde, durante su discurso al mediodía, el Santo Padre dio gracias por el Apóstol de la Divina Misericordia. "Durante esta celebración, junto con ustedes, le agradecí a Dios que hace casi un año me otorgó la gracia de canonizar a Sor Faustina Kowalska, la elegida apóstol del Cristo misericordioso, y de proclamar el Segundo Domingo de Pascua como la Fiesta de lo Divino. Misericordia para toda la Iglesia ".

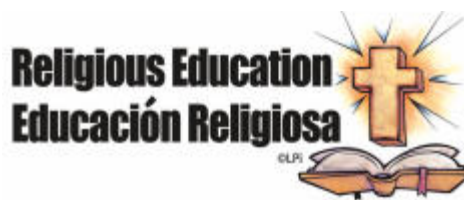

NEW LIFE

When Jesus appeared to his disciples after his resurrection, he convinced them that he was not a ghost but the same one that they had known as their teacher and friend. To his frightened and doubtful friends, he said: "See by my hands and my feet that it is I myself. Touch me and see for yourselves" (Luke 24: 39). Then he asked them for something to eat, and later, when he appeared to them for the third time, he offered them breakfast, bread and fish (see Luke 24: 42-3 and John 21: 12-14).

But Jesus also showed them that his body was a new spiritual body, no longer subject to the laws of nature. While the doors of the room where the disciples had gathered were closed, Jesus came and stood among them (see John 20: 19), and when he offered them breakfast, nobody dared to ask: 'Who are you?' They knew it was Jesus, their Lord and teacher, but they also knew that he no longer belonged to their world (see John 21: 12). It was this experience of the risen Jesus that revealed to his disciples the life in the resurrection that was awaiting them. Are there any experiences in our lives that give us a hint of the new life that has been promised us?

The Image of Jesus, the Divine Mercy

The image of Jesus, the Divine Mercy, is to have a special place of honor on the Feast of Mercy, a visual reminder of all that Jesus did for us through His Passion, Death and Resurrection and a reminder, too, of what He asks of us in return – to trust Him and be merciful to others. St. John Paul II said: "Jesus shows His hands and His side [to the apostles]. He points, that is, to the wounds of the Passion, especially the wound in His heart, the source from which flows the great wave of mercy poured out on humanity."

NUEVA VIDA

Cuando Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos después de su resurrección, los convenció de que no era un fantasma, sino el mismo que habían conocido como Su maestro y amigo. A sus amigos asustados y dudosos, les dijo: "Vean por mis manos y mis pies que soy yo mismo. Tócame y compruébalo por ti mismo" (Lucas 24:39). Luego les pidió algo de comer, y más tarde, cuando se les apareció por tercera vez, les ofreció desayuno, pan y pescado (véase Lucas 24: 42-3 y Juan 21: 12-14).

Pero Jesús también les mostró que su cuerpo era un nuevo cuerpo espiritual, que ya no estaba sujeto a las leyes de la naturaleza. Mientras las puertas de la sala donde se habían reunido los discípulos estaban cerradas, Jesús vino y se paró entre ellos (véase Juan 20: 19), y cuando les ofreció el desayuno, nadie se atrevió a preguntar: '¿Quién eres?'. Sabían que era Jesús, su Señor y maestro, pero también sabían que ya no pertenecía a su mundo (véase Juan 21:12). Fue esta experiencia del Jesús resucitado la que reveló a sus discípulos la vida en la resurrección que les estaba esperando. ¿Hay alguna experiencia en nuestras vidas que nos dé una pista de la nueva vida que se nos ha prometido?
