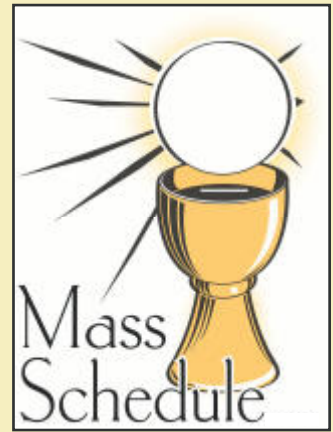
9:00 am Mass OLMC: suspended until Sunday September 13th!

WEEKDAY MASSES / SUNDAY MASSES



Thanks so much for returning to Church for attending the Weekday and Sunday Masses.

A good number of parishioners have volunteered as ushers and sanitizers and I am grateful for their help as our first priority remains always your safety and wellbeing.

Some of you who are at a higher risk for COVID-19 (i.e., those who are older than 65 or who have underlying health conditions) are cautioned **NOT** to come to church for Mass. Those who feel in any way sick should not enter the church but stay at home for one's own sake and for the sake of others.

Thanks so much for your cooperation in following the instructions given by the ushers like how to enter and where to sit. We are complying with the directives given to us and therefore:

- We **sanitize our hands** at the entrance of the Church
- We **observe social distancing** sitting 6 feet away or more from others. Families may sit together but 6 feet should be maintained between households.
- We **keep our facemask on** throughout the Mass .
- We have **no offertory procession**.
- We **omit the handshake** or any form of physical contact during the Sign of Peace.

Before receiving Holy Communion:

Please, note that when **standing in line** for Holy Communion, we **maintain six feet** between you and the person ahead of you. Please, follow the guidance from the ushers.

- When receiving Holy Communion, you can **ONLY** receive Holy Communion reverently in open hands for the protection of all.
- You remove your facemask **ONLY** after having received Holy Communion in the hand.
- If you are wearing gloves, you **MUST REMOVE** them before receiving Holy Communion.
- If you cannot receive in your hand, please, just ask for a blessing.

After the Mass is ended:

- When you **exit** your pew, please, maintain 6 feet of social distancing and avoid congregating in small groups. Please, follow the instruction of the ushers.
- **Our Lady of Mount Carmel (OLMC):** unless unable to do the stairs and you are in need of the elevator, we ask that everyone leave from the back of the Church onto Lexington Avenue.

Please, let us pray for all the victims of COVID-19 and for the scientists who are working on a vaccine to put an end to the pandemic.

MISAS DE LAS SEMANAS / MISAS DEL DOMINGO



Muchas gracias por regresar a la Iglesia por asistir a las Misas de los semanas y los domingos.

Un buen número de feligreses se han ofrecido como ujieres y desinfectantes y estoy agradecido por su ayuda, ya que nuestra primera prioridad sigue siendo siempre su seguridad y bienestar.

Se les advierte a algunos de ustedes que tienen un mayor riesgo de COVID-19 (es decir, aquellos que son mayores de 65 años o que tienen afecciones de salud subyacentes) que **NO** asistan a la iglesia para la misa. Aquellos que se sientan de alguna manera enfermos no deben ingresar al iglesia pero quedarse en casa por el propio bien y por el bien de los demás.

Muchas gracias por su cooperación en seguir las instrucciones dadas por los ujieres, como cómo ingresar y dónde sentarse. Cumplimos con las directivas que nos dieron y por lo tanto:

- **Desinfertarnos nuestras manos** a la entrada de la Iglesia.
- **Observamos distanciamiento social** sentado a seis pies de distancia o más de los demás. Las familias pueden sentarse juntas, pero se deben mantener 6 pies entre los hogares.
- **Mantenemos nuestra máscara facial** durante toda la Misa
- **No tenemos procesión de ofertorio.**
- **Omitimos el apretón de manos** o cualquier forma de contacto físico durante el Signo de la Paz.

Antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión:

- Tenga en cuenta que al hacer cola para la Sagrada Comunión, **mantenemos seis pies** entre usted y la persona que tiene delante. Por favor, siga las instrucciones de los ujieres.
- Al recibir la Sagrada Comunión, **SOLO** puedes recibir la Sagrada Comunión con reverencia en las manos abiertas para la protección de todos.
- **SOLO** te quitas la máscara después de haber recibido la Sagrada Comunión en la mano. Si usa guantes, **DEBE QUITARLOS** antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Si no puede recibir en su mano, por favor, solo pida una bendición.

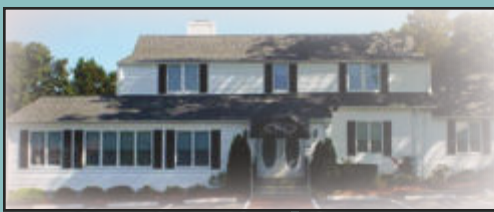
Después de que termine la Misa:

- **Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo (OLMC):** a menos que no pueda subir las escaleras y necesite el ascensor, le pedimos a todos que salgan desde la parte posterior de la Iglesia hacia Lexington Avenue.

Por favor, recemos por todas las víctimas de COVID-19 y por los científicos que están trabajando en una vacuna para poner fin a la pandemia.
