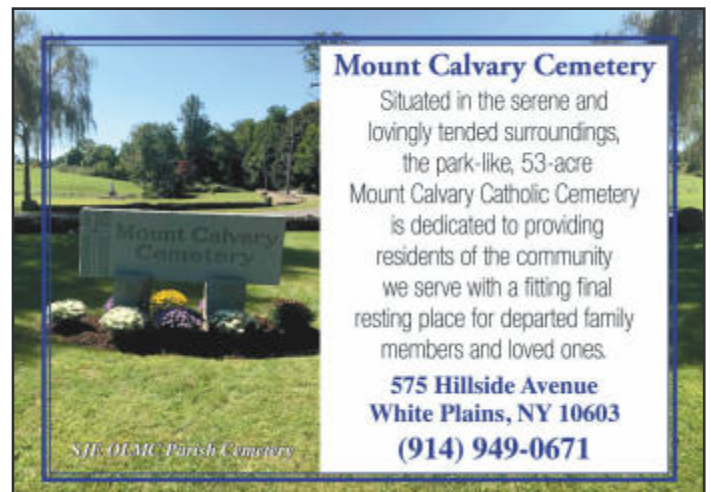

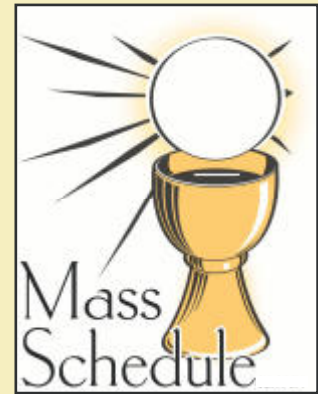

## CARE OF CREATION CORNER: Lenten Reflections on Integral Ecology

Readings: Ex. 20:1-17; Ps. 19; 1Cor. 1:18-25; Jn. 2:13-22 (3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent)

evolution of creation. Just as so does exploitation of land

**To Keep in Mind:** Jesus knew that people engaged in commerce. It only riled him when it was done inappropriately, without respect for sacred life and the good of all. This week, we'll consider a few ways that species and their habitats are misused leading to their endangerment or extinction. Remember that each creature reflects divinity, each is interconnected with the whole, and each is part of the continuing aborting humans deprives us of precious life and what each individual can contribute, and forests deprive us and other species of a richer future and even life.

**Question for reflection:** Remember that our creator sustains all life. How might Jesus want us to defend it?

**Action:** In what ways do my purchases contribute to exploitation of others and of creation? If people are stripping forests to sell lumber and to raise beef cattle, can I modify what I buy and consume? For example, if it takes 1,700 gallons of water to produce a pound of beef, one less hamburger a week saves 425 gallons of water. Are there times when I can buy used furniture instead of new? In what other ways can I conserve resources?

**Prayer:** The heavens declare your glory, O God. And like a champion, the sun daily runs its course with joy. According to your will, the vernal equinox is at hand as the light of day begins to exceed the darkness. Grant your grace to farmers and gardeners who, in these lengthening days, plant the fields in hope of harvest that all your children may eat in joy.

**A tener en cuenta:** Jesús sabía que la gente se dedicaba al comercio. Sólo lo enfureció cuando se hizo de manera inapropiada, sin respeto por la vida sagrada y el bien de todos. Esta semana, consideraremos algunas formas en las que las especies y sus hábitats se utilizan de manera indebida, lo que los pone en peligro o en vías de extinción. Recuerden que cada criatura refleja la divinidad, cada una está interconectada con el todo y cada una es parte de la evolución continua de la creación. Así como el aborto de seres humanos nos priva de una vida preciosa y de lo que cada individuo puede aportar, la explotación de la tierra y los bosques nos priva a nosotros y a otras especies de un futuro más rico e incluso de una vida.

**Pregunta para reflexionar:** Recuerda que nuestro creador sustenta toda la vida. ¿Cómo querría Jesús que lo defendiéramos?

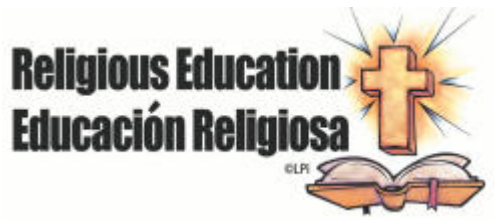
**Acción:** ¿De qué manera mis compras contribuyen a la explotación de los demás y de la creación? Si la gente está talando bosques para vender madera y criar ganado de carne, ¿puedo modificar lo que compro y consumo? Por ejemplo, si se necesitan 1,700 galones de agua para producir una libra de carne, una hamburguesa menos a la semana ahorra 425 galones de agua. ¿Hay ocasiones en las que puedo comprar muebles usados en lugar de nuevos? ¿De qué otras formas puedo conservar los recursos?

# The Year of St. Joseph / The Feast of St Joseph

An Age-Old Italian Tradition



According to legend, there was a famine in Sicily many centuries ago. The villagers prayed to St. Joseph, seeking his intercession to end the drought and provide for their families. Their prayers were answered. In thanksgiving they began the custom of celebrating his feast with the most precious gifts they had, food. Over the years the celebration has taken on many traditions and customs, the most popular is the St. Joseph's Table.

Typically, it has been filled with breads baked in the shape of carpenter's tools, pastries, especially St. Joseph sfinge and zeppole, oranges, lemons and fava beans which were the staple food and saved the Sicilians from starvation during the famine. At Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church, every year we have set a table with the statue of St. Joseph and flowers. Over the years and in keeping with Italian tradition donated food has been blessed during mass and then donated to the Ecumenical Food Pantry of Westchester located at the Slater Center and to those in need in honor of Saint Joseph as a form of public charity. **Please** consider bringing donated food to the table on this special year of St. Joseph.

The blessing of the Saint Joseph Table will take place during the 9:00 am Mass at OLMC on Sun. March 14<sup>th</sup>.

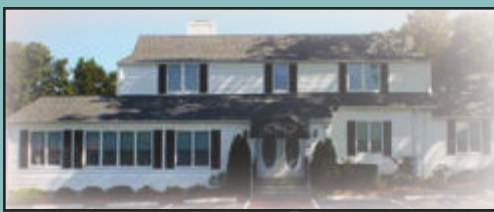
