## Building Project Update

**Building Update 5/29/19:** The windows to the offices in the school building have been installed. The exterior doors and windows should be installed in the next couple of weeks. With the electrical and HVAC roughed in we are expecting the insulation to begin soon and drywall. On the exterior of the building we are looking forward to the brick and stucco in the first weeks of June. The project is still on track for a late July completion. There will be some announcements coming soon on some small work parties to help prepare the church to receive new paint and flooring. We are working out the specific dates with the contractors, so the sign-ups will be coming soon. This is just one of several ways we are able to help as a community to keep the construction costs down!
