BAPTISMS

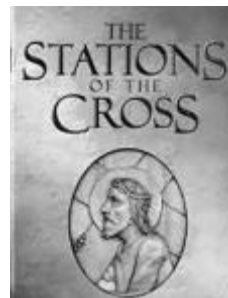
