CEMETERY CORNER

A Few General Cemetery Regulations Reminders

- Pets are prohibited on cemetery property.
- Cemetery dumpsters are for cemetery use **ONLY**, not for personal household trash.
- Fences, hedges, coping, edging, curbing, enclosures, ironwork, wires, seats, vases, urns, posts, and steps are prohibited on cemetery plots/ property.
- Articles such as shells, rocks, stone chips, bottles, cans, mulch, glass receptacles, styrofoam crosses, statues & all other decorative non-religious objects will be removed from cemetery property without notice.
 - Outlining of graves or memorials by stripping a border of sod or outlining the grave with metal frames, stones, concrete blocks, etc. is not permitted.
- The planting of evergreens, trees, shrubbery, rose bushes, large bushy flowers, vegetable plants, etc. of any kind is strictly prohibited and will be removed without notice by cemetery personnel.
- American flags with holders must be placed next to the headstone of each grave and not by the VA marker with the exception of two weeks prior to and then two weeks after Memorial Day.

These rules among others are based on Diocesan Cemetery Rules.

Please take a ride to Holy Cross or Resurrection Cemeteries to see the difference.

Please adhere & respect these rules for the general order and cleanliness of our parish cemetery.

CEMETERY NOTICE

- All dead flowers must be removed.
- Please, no walls, rocks, boundaries, overgrown plants & bushes, etc.; they will be removed without notice.

13 Niedziela zwykła

30 Czerwiec, 2019

Słowo Boże na 13 niedzielę zwykłą zachęca do zdecydowanego pójścia za Chrystusem, do postawienia w życiu na wartości duchowe, do przyznania w nim Bogu właściwego, pierwszego miejsca.

Słowa Eliasza są mocne, a Jezusa zdają się być nawet za mocne. Czy Jezus rzeczywiście nie chce, byśmy pochowali naszych zmarłych (co kryje się za tymi „zmarłymi”)? Czy chce, żebyśmy porzucili naszych bliskich, drugiego człowieka i zajęli się tylko Nim? Bez jasnego wytłumaczenia myśli Jezusa przez głoszącego kapłana, bez przełożenia jej na realia codzienności, możemy być pewni, że niejeden zrażony słuchacz odsunie ją od siebie, inny pozostawi ze znakiem zapytania, a jeszcze inny pomyśli „jakie to słowo zawikłane, czy nie można prosto powiedzieć, czego się oczekuje?”.

Czy więc pójść za Jezusem to znaczy spędzać wiele godzin codziennie na modlitwie? Czy to znaczy codziennie być w kościele, oddać wszystko co się ma na Boże cele, a może chodzić po domach i głosić Boga? A może to znaczy zapytać, co Jezus by zrobił w danej sytuacji i tak uczynić? Może sięgnąć po fragment słowa i starać się według niego przeżyć dzień? Może zrezygnować z ziemskiej przyjemności ciała dla Boga czy dobrej sprawy? Może trochę przewartościować codzienny plan, tak żeby nie zabrakło w nim centralnej osi – osobistego kontaktu z Bogiem? Może dążyć do tego, żeby zrobić coś codziennie dla drugiego człowieka, umieć zrezygnować z czegoś dla siebie, aby było to dla bliźniego? Jakże trafnym dopełnieniem i wyjaśnieniem wymagań Jezusa są rady św. Pawła z Listu do Galatów, mówiące o ciele i duchu, i o prawdziwej wolności. W tak wyjaśnionym kontekście każdy zrozumie jak iść zdecydowanie za Bogiem.
