HAPPY INDEPENDENCE DAY!

14 Niedziela zwykła

7 Lipiec 2019

Żyjemy w świecie, który każdego dnia, za pośrednictwem środków masowego przekazu przynosi nam złe wieści: codziennie oglądamy zniszczenia, łzy i krew w krajach objętych wojnami, uprowadzenia dzieci, procesy dążące do ukarania winnych. Przede wszystkim nie zamykamy oczu i nie zatykamy uszu. Nie przyzwyczajajmy się. Nie bądźmy nieczuli na wszystkie te dramaty, jakbyśmy byli bezradni.

Słowa Chrystusa: „Żniwo wprawdzie wielkie, ale robotników mało”, są jak najbardziej aktualne teraz i to już na skalę światową.

Jezus i dziś wysyła swoich uczniów na żniwo. Kim są ci powołani?

Doskonale wiemy jaką rolę w kontaktach międzyludzkich spełnia świadectwo osoby - która żyjąc dla jakiejś wartości - stara się ją przekazać innym, poprzez całkowite oddanie się dla niej. Nie chodzi tu o jakieś heroiczne czyny, poświęcenie, a raczej o bycie zwyczajnym człowiekiem. - Takim, który po prostu się modli, mieszka, rozmawia, wypełnia swoje obowiązki rodzinne. Pozostaje sobą niezależnie od domu w którym przebywa, od ludzi, jacy go otaczają.

Za czasów Chrystusa potrzebne było świadectwo życia ludzi prawych. Tak i teraz, w naszym wieku, jakże ważne jest to, aby każdy chrześcijanin, który wierzy, że Chrystus żył i za nas poniósł śmierć męczeńską był świadkiem bożej miłości i tą miłością żył na codzień, obdarowując nią innych.

Bóg postanowił szerzyć swoje Królestwo miłości i sprawiedliwości, radości i pokoju, posługując się nami. Naszymi rękami, nogami, ustami, sercami. Czy je oddamy Chrystusowi wielkodusznie już od tej chwili, czy też tak, jak dotąd: ostrożnie, z wyliczeniem, połowicznie? Nie zapominajmy, że Chrystus tego swojego dzieła może dokonać jedynie za pomocą takich apostołów, którzy Go miłują z całego serca i ze wszystkich sił. Takiego właśnie świadectwa potrzebuje od chrześcijanina dzisiaj świat: tej zwyczajnej żywej miłości w naszych domach, w miejscach pracy i szkołach, wszędzie tam gdzie są uczniowie Pana, który powiedział: „Po tym wszyscy poznają, żeście uczniami moimi, jeśli będziecie się wzajemnie miłowali”.
