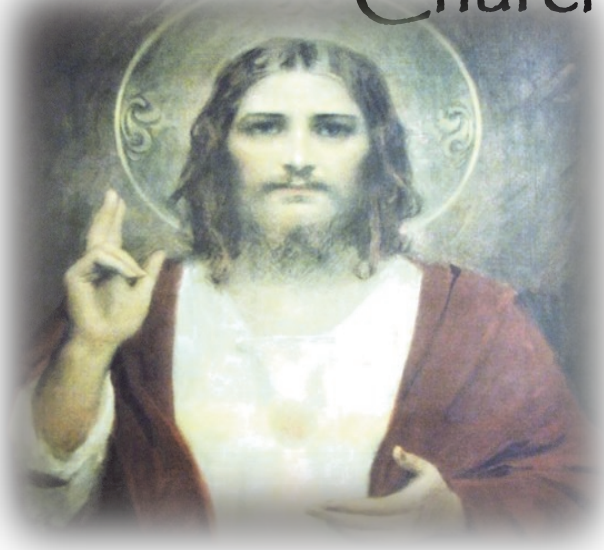

SACRAMENT OF HOLY MATRIMONY / WEDDINGS

Arrangements are to be made by calling the Parish Office no less than ONE YEAR in advance. Absolutely NO social plans are to be made before meeting with the parish Priest or Deacon. Please note: Sacrament of Holy Matrimony is celebrated on Saturdays @ 2:00pm only, NO Friday nor Sunday weddings (nuptials) will be scheduled.

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on the 2nd & 4th Sunday at 1:30PM with the exception of Holy Days. **Pre-Baptism class**, will be at 2:00 pm every 2nd Saturday of the month in Church. Parents and Godparents must attend.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA)

The RCIA is the process the Church uses to form and inform those who want to "inquire" about the Catholic faith. This process is for those who have never been baptized, baptized adults needing Confirmation and Holy Eucharist, and those of other faiths who feel called to become Catholic. Is God calling you? STOP INFANTICIDE

Some states are proposing laws to expand abortion and to repeal laws providing specific protections for babies born alive after surviving an attempted abortion. A particular piece of legislation - **The Born-Alive Survivors Protection Act** (S.311/H.R.962) would provide protections nationwide to help prevent newborns from being killed or being left alone to die. Sadly, the United States has failed to pass the **Born-Alive Survivors Protection Act**. But there is still hope!

Serdeczne Bóg Zapłać wszystkim którzy ofiarowali pieniądze na remont dachu na Memorial Hall/Sala Parafialna. Dach jest już zrobiony. Jeden projekt skończony. Originalna oszacowana cena na remont dachu była \$28,500.00. Ale wiedząc że będziemy potrzebowali więcej niż oszacowanych płyt na zamianę spruchniałego drewna na dachu, doszedł dodatkowy koszt o \$7,865.00 (za extra płyty na wymienienie spruchniałego drewna). To znaczy że cały koszt nowego dachu na Memorial Hall wyszedł na \$36,365.00. Dzięki waszej dobroci was wszystkich dobrych parafian, zebraliśmy \$34,234.00 na remont dachu. To znaczy że nam zabrakło \$2,131.00.

W imieniu kościoła chcę podziękować wam wszystkim którzy poświęciliście się i chojnie dali pieniądze na remont dachu Memorial Hall. Serdeczne Bóg Zapłać! Wiem że wielu nie było stać na danie funduszu na remont dachu, ale także wiem dobrze że wielu ma możliwość na chojność ale z jednego powodu albo z drugiego nie udzielili się.
