“For to me, living is Christ...” (Philippians 1:21) St. Paul’s message conveys an attitude of sacrifice and humble service to be lived by all in proclaiming the Gospel. Essential to the work of the Church are the many dedicated lay women and men of the Diocese of Paterson who continually live as faithful stewards of God’s grace and generosity. In 2009, Bishop Serratelli created a Diocesan Honor to recognize the contributions of the faithful to the mission of Christ and His Church. Every year, parishes nominate an individual, a couple or a family to receive The Vivere Christus Est Award.

This Year I have nominated Mrs. Carol Scanlan for the Vivere Christus Est Award. Carol is an outstanding woman of faith and true disciple of our Lord by investing forty-four years of her life working for the Diocese of Paterson.
