- In addition to the repertoire above, you can request any song published in our **parish hymnal**.
- Most songs for the *bridal processional* and *recessional* work interchangeably.
- Musicians are hired to play for the wedding liturgy itself. A selection of appropriate music will be graciously offered as a **prelude** before the liturgy starts while the guests are being seated.
- Musicians hired for your wedding liturgy are *not* under the administration of your wedding coordinator.

Christ the King has a group of professional musicians available for wedding liturgies. This fee applies if you choose to use a cantor or instrumentalist that is not part of our music team.

Outside Repertoire \$50 (each song)

If you have a request for a song that are outside of this repertoire, please, feel free to mention it. We will do our best to fulfill your request depending on musician's availability and the requirements of the Catholic liturgical guidelines. This additional fee applies to each different song to cover the cost of extra rehearsal, arrangements and sheet music required.
