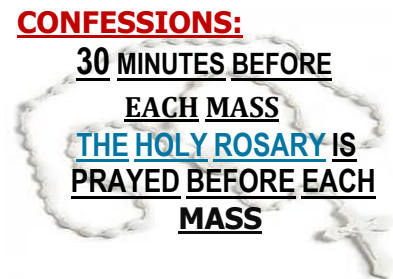

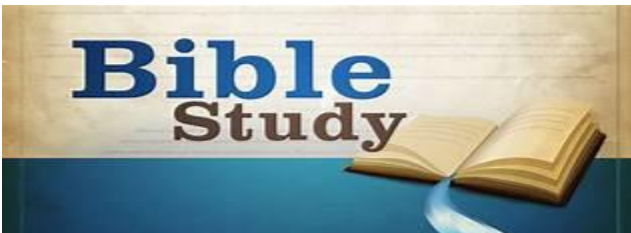

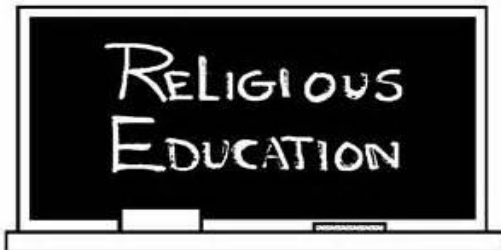


### DCCW BRAZOS VALLEY AUGUST MEETING
