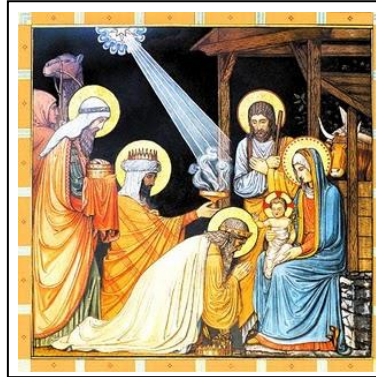

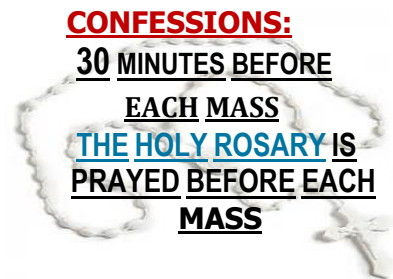

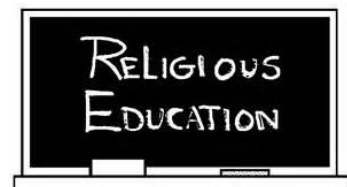
### Parish Breakfast:
