Bus numbers from:

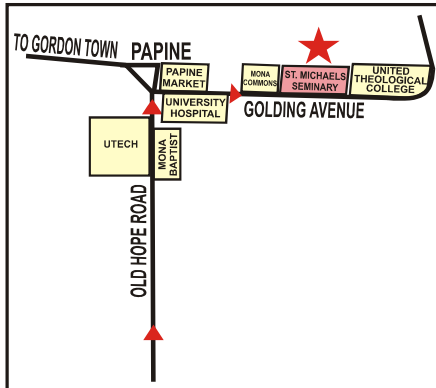
**Half Way Tree** - 70, 75

# Programme

This programme aims to prepare persons for teaching Religious Education in Schools. The teacher is trained to help students come to a deeper experience in their relationship with God and each other. Its aim is to foster Christian values and ethics and encourage students to reflect on religious education and its impact on their lives and choices.

## Target Group

**Lay Ministers, religious communities, teachers of religion, persons generally interested in their own and the spiritual growth of others.**

## Requirements

Minimum requirement 5 CXC subjects including English (general proficiency grades I-III). With consideration given when there is less than 5 CXC passes to personal maturity and work experience.

- ◆ Applicants can begin the programme in either September or January

To receive certification students must

- ◆ Earn 36 credits (12 x 3 credit course or a combination of 3 credit courses and modules)
- ◆ Attend at least one course per semester

## Semester Duration

- ◆ **Full Time - three (3) Semesters OR**
- ◆ **Part-time -students must take at least ONE (1) course each semester.**

## COURSES

### Core Courses which must be taken:

- ◆ Introduction to New Testament Literature
- ◆ History of the Church from Pentecost to Charlemagne
- ◆ Introduction to Systematic Theology
- ◆ Introduction to Theological Ethics
- ◆ Introduction to Christian Worship

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CORE COURSES

- ◆ Introduction to the Study of Religion
- ◆ Comparative Religions
- ◆ Rites of Christian Initiation
- ◆ Approaches to Christian Education
- ◆ Ministry to Youth

### The remaining TWO courses (one from each area) are to be chosen from the following:

#### BIBLICAL STUDIES

- ◆ The Pentateuch – the first five books.
- ◆ The Latter Prophets –Amos
- ◆ Micah, Isaiah, Jeremiah

## COURSES

- ◆ Theology of Deuteronomy and the Deuteronomistic History
- ◆ Exilic Literature – Israel during the Babylonian Exile
- ◆ The Synoptic Gospels
- ◆ Pauline Epistles – Paul's letters
- ◆ The Gospel and Epistles of John
- ◆ Israelite Wisdom – The Books of Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Sirach, Wisdom of Solomon
- ◆ The Acts of the Apostles
- ◆ Pauline Theology
