Below is important information to begin the school year:

Curriculum Night - Wednesday September 12th at 7pm

The Curriculum Night Program, hosted by the Parents Club will begin with a brief program in the School Hall. - Sixth grade students are required to have a measles booster and hepatitis immunization by August 31. These are available through private doctors or the county Public Health Department..
