Below is important information to begin the school year:

Curriculum Night - Wednesday September 11th at 7pm

The Curriculum Night Program, hosted by the Parents Club will begin with a brief program in the School Hall. After the overview presentation, the program will move to the classrooms for teacher presentations. This is a great opportunity to review the particular curriculum and classroom procedures for your child and learn about the activities and expectations of the Parents' Club and School Commission.

Morning carpool -

Prior to 8:20 am there is no supervision for the students. If you are here before 8:20 your children need to wait in the car until a staff member opens the door. This is to insure their safety.

All School Mass: Just a reminder that on liturgy days the students dress in formal wear (sweater vests and ties). Our first all school mass will be Friday, September 27th. All school mass is usually on Fridays except for Holy days of obligation. Holy day of obligation mass will replace the Friday mass. All parents are welcome to attend our liturgies

Immunization: All schools are requested to keep current on the immunization of the students. Here are the requirements:

- Kindergarten students must have their four year old immunizations boosters: oral Polio and the combined DPT
- Sixth grade students are required to have a measles booster and hepatitis immunization by August 31. These are available through private doctors or the county Public Health Department..
