PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, DURING THE MASS THE PRIEST SAYS AT THE CONSECRATION, “HE TOOK BREAD... AND BROKE IT.” THE BREAKING OF BREAD APPEARS A NUMBER OF TIMES IN THE GOSPELS. JESUS BROKE BREAD BEFORE FEEDING THE 5,000 AND THE 4,000. THE TWO DISCIPLES, WHO WERE ON THEIR WAY TO EMMAUS AFTER JESUS' RESURRECTION, RECOGNIZED JESUS IN THE BREAKING OF BREAD, AND IN THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES, THE EARLY CHURCH CONCERNED ITSELF WITH PRAYER AND BREAKING OF BREAD. THE BREAKING OF BREAD IS THE SIGN OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARIST. THE FEEDING OF THE 5,000 AND 4,000 WAS A FORESHADOWING OF WHAT JESUS WOULD DO AT THE LAST SUPPER AND WHAT THE FOLLOWERS DID AFTER CHRIST'S RESURRECTION FROM THE DEAD. THE BREAKING OF BREAD IS A SIGN OF JESUS'S LOVE FOR US. HE HAD LOVE AND COMPASSION FOR THE CROWDS WHEN HE FED THEM; HE WAS WILLING TO SACRIFICE HIS LIFE ON THE CROSS; HIS BODY WAS BRUTALLY SCOURGED AND NAILED TO A CROSS AND, ALTHOUGH HIS BONES WERE NOT BROKEN, HIS BODY WAS BROKEN IN SPIRIT AND LIFE AND HIS BLOOD WAS SHED TO THE LAST DROP, EVEN TO THE POINT OF BLOOD AND WATER FLOWING FROM HIS SIDE. THE BROKEN BREAD OF THE EUCHARIST IS JESUS'S ULTIMATE SACRIFICE TO FREE US FROM SIN AND DEATH; IT SHOWS US THE EXTENT OF LOVE JESUS HAD FOR US SO THAT WE COULD SHARE IN HIS DIVINE LIFE. JESUS IN THE EUCHARIST REMINDS US OF WHAT HE WAS WILLING TO DO FOR US AND INVITES US TO UNITE OUR LIVES WITH HIS.
