THROUGH THE SOCIETY FOR THE PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH WE SUPPORT THE MISSION OF JESUS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. THIS COLLECTION ENABLES THE CHURCH IN THE MISSION FIELDS TO CONTINUE AND INCREASE ITS HEALING AND SAVING WORK AMONG THE POOREST OF OUR SISTERS AND BROTHERS. IN MORE THAN 1,150 MISSION DIOCESES WORLDWIDE, PRIESTS, RELIGIOUS BROTHERS AND SISTERS, AND LAY CATECHISTS RELY ON THE PRAYERS AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM SPOF. THEY COUNT ON THIS SUPPORT AS THEY HELP YOUNG PEOPLE WHO ARE SEARCHING FOR THE MEANING OF LIFE, AS THEY HELP REFUGEES IN THEIR SPIRITUAL AND MATERIAL NEEDS, AS THEY MINISTER TO THE SICK IN HOSPITALS, AS THEY TEACH CHILDREN IN SCHOOLS, AS THEY PREPARE ADULTS FOR BAPTISM, OR AS THEY HELP THOSE WHO SUFFER BECAUSE OF WAR AND NATURAL DISASTERS.

PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, IT'S AMAZING WHAT WE KNOW ABOUT GOD IN WHOM WE BELIEVE. ALONG WITH OTHER RELIGIONS SUCH AS JUDAISM AND ISLAM WE PROFESS ONE GOD BUT CHRISTIANS HAVE QUITE A DIFFERENT UNDERSTANDING WHO GOD IS. DURING HIS LIFE ON EARTH JESUS TALKED ABOUT HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD. JESUS REVEALED THE SUPERNATURAL LIFE OF GOD OF WHICH WE COULD NEVER CONCEIVE WITHOUT JESUS'S INSIGHT. FIRST, JESUS SHOWED US THE TRINITARIAN LIFE OF GOD: FATHER, SON, AND HOLY SPIRIT. JESUS CERTAINLY DID NOT USE THE TERM, HOLY TRINITY; HOWEVER, HE DID SPEAK OF THE FATHER AND THE SON IN A NUMBER OF PLACES IN SCRIPTURE SUCH AS WHEN HE SAID, "NO ONE KNOWS THE SON EXCEPT THE FATHER, AND NO ONE KNOWS THE FATHER EXCEPT THE SON AND ANYONE TO WHOM THE SON WISHES TO REVEAL HIM (MT. 11:27)." JESUS ALSO SPOKE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, "THE ADVOCATE, THE HOLY SPIRIT, THAT THE FATHER WILL SEND IN MY NAME—HE WILL TEACH YOU EVERYTHING AND REMIND YOU OF ALL THAT I TOLD YOU (JN 14:26)." FROM REFERENCES LIKE THIS, THEOLOGIANS REALIZED THREE PERSONS IN ONE GOD AND APPLIED THE TERM, HOLY TRINITY. SECOND, JESUS ALSO REVEALED WHAT GOD IS LIKE THROUGH HIS WORDS AND ACTIONS. HE SHOWED THAT GOD IS LOVE THROUGH THE MERCY HE SHOWED, HIS ACCEPTANCE OF OTHERS, HIS FORGIVENESS OF

THE SINS OF OTHERS. JESUS ALSO REVEALED MUCH MORE IN THE GOSPELS. JESUS WAS ULTIMATELY TO GIVE HIS LIFE FOR US ON THE CROSS TO BRING FORGIVENESS OF SINS AND TO REVEAL THE MEANING OF SUFFERING AND DEATH IN OUR LIVES. OUR FAITH IS BUILT ON WHAT JESUS HAS REVEALED. JESUS GIVES US THE GRACE TO ACCEPT THESE REVELATIONS AND LIVE OUR FAITH.
