PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, JANUARY 22 WAS THE FORTY SEVENTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SUPREME COURT'S DECISION OF ROE V. WADE WHICH ALLOWED THE LEGALIZATION OF ABORTION IN THE UNITED STATES. IT REVEALS THE HEIGHT OF OUR ARROGANCE AS HUMAN BEINGS FOR IN DOING THIS WE ARE ESSENTIALLY TELLING GOD, OUR CREATOR, THAT WE ARE GODS; WE SEPARATED OURSELVES FROM GOD, AND NO LONGER NEED HIM.
