ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY ARE DAYS OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE. ALL OTHER FRIDAY'S DURING LENT ARE DAYS OF ABSTINENCE. ON DAYS OF FAST, ONLY ONE FULL MEAL IS TAKEN WITH TWO OTHERS OF LESSER QUANTITY. ON DAYS OF ABSTINENCE, MEAT IS NOT TO BE EATEN. THE LAW OF FAST APPLIES TO THOSE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 18 AND 59, AND THE LAW OF ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT APPLIES TO THOSE 14 AND OVER.

## PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, HOLY TRINITY SCHOOL PLAYS AN IMPORTANT PART IN THE LIFE OF HOLY TRINITY

CHURCH AND THE SOMERSET COMMUNITY. SINCE 1830, WHEN A GIRLS ACADEMY WAS ESTABLISHED, A CATHOLIC EDUCATION WAS OFFERED TO OUR STUDENTS. THIS EDUCATION CONTINUES TODAY. A STRONG ACADEMIC PROGRAM NOT ONLY EMPHASIZES THE THREE R'S: READING, 'RITING, 'RITHMATIC, BUT SERVICE TO NEIGHBORS AND OTHERS IN NEED. THE STUDENTS LEARN THAT THEY ARE CALLED TO USE THEIR SKILLS TO HELP OTHERS, AND NOT JUST THEMSELVES. AN ACTIVE SPORTS PROGRAM PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE BOYS AND GIRLS INTERESTED IN BASEBALL, BASKETBALL, TRACK AND FOOTBALL FOR THE BOYS AND VOLLEYBALL FOR THE GIRLS WHICH HELPS TO MAINTAIN A MENS SANA IN CORPORE SANO (A HEALTHY MIND IN A HEALTHY BODY). MOST IMPORTANTLY, THOUGH, IS THE PASSING ON OF OUR FAITH TO OUR STUDENTS. THIS INVOLVES MORE THAN MERELY LEARNING THE BASICS OF OUR FAITH, BUT OF COMING TO KNOW OUR SAVIOR, JESUS CHRIST, AND GROWING IN A DEEP RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM IN THEIR LIVES. EACH DAY THE STUDENTS BEGIN THE DAY BY ASSEMBLING AND PRAYING AS A STUDENT BODY. STUDENTS OF OTHER FAITHS JOIN IN THESE PRAYERS AND INSTRUCTIONS BUT ARE NOT FORCED TO CONVERT. WE RESPECT THE FAITH BELIEFS OF THESE STUDENTS AND DO NOT PROSELYTIZE, BUT FEEL IT IS IMPORTANT TO HEAR ABOUT RELIGION SO THAT THEY CAN MAKE THE BEST DECISIONS IN THEIR LIVES. THE MORNING ASSEMBLY ENDS WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND THE SINGING OF A SONG SUCH AS GOD BLESS AMERICA. THE STUDENTS ACKNOWLEDGE THEIR GRATITUDE TO THE SACRIFICES THEIR FORBEARERS MADE IN SETTLING OUR LAND AND DEFENDING OUR COUNTRY TO GIVE THEM THE STANDARD OF LIFE AND OPPORTUNITIES THEY ENJOY. HOLY TRINITY SCHOOL WILL SOON BE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR THE COMING SCHOOL YEAR.
