CATHOLIC HOME MISSIONS COLLECTION

THIS WEEKEND, JUNE 13 & 14, THE COLLECTION FOR THE CATHOLIC HOME MISSIONS WILL BE TAKEN UP AT ALL THE MASSES. RIGHT NOW, OVER 40% OF DIOCESES IN THE US ARE CONSIDERED HOME MISSIONS BECAUSE THEY ARE UNABLE TO FUND ESSENTIAL PASTORAL WORK NEEDED IN THEIR COMMUNITIES. YOUR SUPPORT OF THIS APPEAL WILL HELP FUND PROGRAMS SUCH AS RELIGIOUS EDUCATION, SEMINARY FORMATION, AND LAY MINISTRY TRAINING—TO BUILD VIBRANT FAITH COMMUNITIES RIGHT HERE IN THE UNITED STATES. PLEASE GIVE WHAT YOU CAN IN THE SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND.

PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, YOU HAVE PROBABLY OBSERVED THE WORK BEING DONE ON THE HOLY TRINITY STAINED GLASS WINDOWS. A COUPLE OF PEOPLE HAVE COMMENTED ON HOW NICE THEY LOOK SINCE THE OPAQUE GLASS WAS REMOVED. WE HAD A VARIETY OF DIFFERENT KINDS OF GLASS AS A PROTECTIVE SHIELD. THE GLASS WAS IN BAD SHAPE WITH PUTTY FALLING OFF THE WINDOW FRAMES. WE WILL BE REPLACING THIS GLASS WITH CLEAR ACRYLIC GLASS. WE WERE PLANNING TO HAVE BEGUN A FUNDRAISER BY NOW BUT COULD NOT BECAUSE OF THE PANDEMIC. WE HAD GONE OUT ON A LIMB BY BEGINNING THE WINDOWS BEFORE THE FUNDRAISER, BUT WE JUSTIFIED IT BY USING THE WINDOWS AS AN INCENTIVE FOR CONTRIBUTING TO THE FUNDRAISER. RIGHT NOW, THE WORK ON THE WINDOWS HAS BECOME A VICTIM OF COVID-19. THE WINDOW ENCASEMENTS ARE MANUFACTURED IN NEW YORK CITY AND THEY HAVE BEEN SHUT DOWN UNTIL THIS PAST MONDAY. IT WILL TAKE ABOUT SIX WEEKS TO MAKE THEM. IT WILL PROBABLY BE MID-AUGUST BEFORE THEY COME BACK TO FINISH THE WORK. WE HAVE DUG INTO OUR MONETARY RESERVES TO PAY FOR THIS SINCE WE HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO HOLD OUR FUNDRAISER, AND WE WERE RECENTLY SHOCKED TO LEARN THAT SOME OF THE STAINED GLASS WINDOW PANES IN FOUR WINDOWS WERE SLIPPING DOWN AND NEEDED TO BE REPAIRED AT A HEFTY PRICE. WE ARE NOW TRYING TO GET ON TRACK WITH OUR FUNDRAISER. WE ARE CALLING IT: BEACON ON THE HILL (BOTH). WE DID FIND OUT SOMETHING RATHER INTERESTING; THE BIG WINDOW OVER THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE CHURCH IS NOT STAINED GLASS BUT PLAIN GLASS. IF ANYONE WOULD LIKE TO DONATE A STAINED-GLASS WINDOW IT WOULD BE MUCH APPRECIATED. WE HAD AN ESTIMATE OF ABOUT \$82,000.00 TO DO THIS. IT WOULD INCLUDE A BACK-LIGHTING BOARD TO ILLUMINATE THIS GLASS SO THAT WE COULD SEE THE GLASS FROM OUTSIDE. WE HOPE TO BEGIN OUR FUNDRAISER SOON.

ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

THE CHURCH ENCOURAGES, EVEN DAILY, HOLY COMMUNION, BUT IF AT ANY TIME WE CANNOT GO TO MASS IN OR OUT OF THIS SEASON OF THE CORONAVIRUS, WE CAN STILL UNITE OURSELVES TO THE EUCHARIST THROUGH MAKING A SPIRITUAL COMMUNION.

BY MAKING A SPIRITUAL COMMUNION, WE EXPRESS OUR FAITH IN CHRIST'S REAL PRESENCE IN THE EUCHARIST AND ASK HIM TO UNITE HIMSELF WITH US. HERE IS THE ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION WRITTEN BY ST. ALPHONSUS DE LIGUORI:

MY JESUS,

I BELIEVE THAT YOU ARE PRESENT IN THE MOST HOLY SACRAMENT,

I LOVE YOU ABOVE ALL THINGS,

AND I DESIRE TO RECEIVE YOU IN TO MY SOUL.

SINCE I CANNOT AT THIS MOMENT RECEIVE YOU SACRAMENTALLY,

COME AT LEAST SPIRITUALLY INTO MY HEART.

I EMBRACE YOU AS IF YOU WERE ALREADY THERE AND UNITE MYSELF WHOLLY TO YOU.

NEVER PERMIT ME TO BE SEPARATED FROM YOU.
