PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, WE ARE LIVING IN A TIME OF CRAZINESS. WE ARE ACTING ON EMOTIONS, RATHER THAN REASON. THIS HAS RESULTED IN A LOT OF DESTRUCTION WITHOUT ANY RHYME OR REASON. ALL OF THIS TO ADDRESS THE PROBLEM OF RACISM. FOR SURE THIS STARTED IN AS A RESULT OF THE VERY HEINOUS MURDER OF GEORGE FLOYD. CERTAINLY, PROTESTS WERE UNDERSTANDABLE, BUT THE RIOTS THAT HAVE ENSUED ARE NOT A SOLUTION TO THE PROBLEM—TWO WRONGS NEVER MAKE A RIGHT. WE TALK ABOUT RACISM IN OUR COUNTRY, BUT WE HAVE NO DEFINITION OF RACISM WHICH HAS RESULTED IN PEOPLE DECLARING ALL SORTS OF ACTIONS WHICH SEEM INNOCENT ENOUGH AS RACISM. I JUST HEARD ON THE RADIO OF A MAN CRACKING HIS KNUCKLES AS HIS HAND HUNG OUT OF A COMPANY TRUCK AND SOMEONE TOOK A PICTURE CLAIMING IT WAS A RACIAL SYMBOL. IT LOOKED LIKE THE OK SIGN (I DIDN'T KNOW THIS WAS A RACIAL SIGN!). THE COMPANY FIRED HIM. IT JUST GOES TO SHOW THAT WHATEVER YOU DO COULD BE TAKEN AS RACIST AND YOU WOULDN'T EVEN KNOW IT; IT ALSO SHOWS HOW HYPED UP WE ARE ABOUT RACISM. LOOK AT HOW

PEOPLE ARE TEARING DOWN STATUES OF CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS AND CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS. WE ARE THROWING THE BABY OUT WITH THE BATH WATER. PULLING DOWN STATUES OR DESTROYING OUR CITIES WILL NOT CORRECT THIS SITUATION. THESE STATUES REPRESENT OUR HISTORY AND CULTURE AND SHOW THAT WE CAN CHANGE AND WORK TO MAKE THE SITUATION BETTER. WE FOUGHT THE CIVIL WAR AGAINST SLAVERY; WE HAD THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT OF THE 60'S AGAINST RACIAL PREJUDICE; AND WE ARE NOW FACING RACIAL ISSUES TODAY. WE CANNOT CHANGE HISTORY. OUR COUNTRY'S DEMOCRATIC SYSTEM OFFERS US THE BEST MEANS OF CORRECTING OUR PROBLEMS THAT NO OTHER GOVERNMENT HAS. OUR COUNTRY SURELY HAS HAD ITS FAILURES, INJUSTICES, AND PREJUDICES, BUT WE HAVE ALWAYS PRIDED OURSELVES AS A NATION OF LAW WHICH HAS HELPED IN THE PAST TO RIGHT INJUSTICES. TO BE CALLING PEOPLE RACISTS OR CONFRONTATIONS RACIAL HATRED OR TRYING TO ABOLISH OUR GOVERNMENT DOES NOT HELP US. WE NEED TO FORGIVE EACH OTHER FOR WRONGS DONE, ACCEPT EACH OTHER FOR WHO EACH ONE IS, AND BE WILLING TO DISCUSS WHAT IS BEST TO SOLVE OUR PROBLEMS.
