LAST WEEKEND WAS THE 2020 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL KICK-OFF WEEKEND. THANK YOU TO THOSE WHO RESPONDED WITH YOUR PLEDGE OR ONE TIME GIFT. FROM HOLY TRINITY PARISH, 9 PARISH FAMILIES RESPONDED WITH A PLEDGE/GIFT TOTALING \$2,300.00. FROM ST. JOSEPH PARISH, 3 PARISH FAMILIES RESPONDED WITH PLEDGES/GIFTS TOTALING \$610.00. WE ARE VERY GRATEFUL FOR THE GENEROSITY OF OUR DONORS. OUR PARISH GOALS SET FOR OUR PARISHES ARE: \$30,810.22 FOR HOLY TRINITY PARISH AND \$12,482.27 FOR ST. JOSEPH PARISH. ### **PASTOR'S NOTE**

PARISHIONERS, DURING THIS TIME OF UNCERTAINTY AND CONFUSION WE EXPERIENCE FEAR ABOUT WHAT WE HEAR OR READ. I FOUND A QUOTE FROM PADRE PIO, NOW SAINT, WHICH OFFERS US COURAGE IN FACING THE FUTURE. HE SAID, "PRAY, HOPE, AND TRUST IN THE LORD." SINCE WE DO NOT KNOW WHAT THE FUTURE WILL BRING, WE ARE BEING CALLED TO PLACE OUR FAITH IN THE LORD KNOWING THAT HE IS LEADING US IN HIS WAY. MY HOPE HAD BEEN THAT THE LORD WOULD ELIMINATE OR CURE THE COVID-19, BUT THAT HAS NOT HAPPENED SO THAT I HAVE STARTED TO THINK THAT THE LORD IS USING THIS TIME TO HAVE US TURN BACK TO HIM. THE STAYING AT HOME AND THE SHUT-DOWN TO MAJOR OUTLETS AND SOCIAL EVENTS HAS GIVEN US TIME TO DO SOME SELF-SEARCHING AND INWARD REFLECTION ON WHAT IS MOST IMPORTANT IN OUR LIVES. WE HAVE HAD TO SEE WHERE WE PUT OUR TRUST AND HOPE. IS IT IN OUR JOBS WHICH WE USE SOMETIMES TO DEFINE WHO WE ARE, OR SPORTS, OR OUR POSSESSIONS? WHAT HAS BEEN MOST IMPORTANT TO US OR WHAT WE HAVE MADE OUR GODS? THE LORD IS GIVING US THIS OPPORTUNITY TO EXAMINE OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM. WHILE WE FIND OURSELVES DEBATING HOW TO OPEN OUR

STORES, RESTAURANTS, BARS, SCHOOLS WE NEED TO TRUST THAT HE IS WITH US TO FACE OUR FEARS TO GO BRAVELY FORWARD. AS WE COME OUT OF HIBERNATION, WE RECOGNIZE HOW MUCH WE NEED TO SOCIALIZE WITH OTHERS WHETHER AT SOCIAL GATHERINGS SPORT EVENTS, SCHOOL, OR MOST IMPORTANTLY CHURCH. WE CAN ONLY DO THIS IF WE HAVE PUT OUR FAITH IN CHRIST, OUR ANCHOR, WHO HOLDS US STEADY IN THIS TIME OF UNCERTAINTY.

### ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

THE CHURCH ENCOURAGES, EVEN DAILY, HOLY COMMUNION, BUT IF AT ANY TIME WE CANNOT GO TO MASS IN OR OUT OF THIS SEASON OF THE CORONAVIRUS, WE CAN STILL UNITE OURSELVES TO THE EUCHARIST THROUGH MAKING A SPIRITUAL COMMUNION.

BY MAKING A SPIRITUAL COMMUNION, WE EXPRESS OUR FAITH IN CHRIST'S REAL PRESENCE IN THE EUCHARIST AND ASK HIM TO UNITE HIMSELF WITH US. HERE IS THE ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION WRITTEN BY ST. ALPHONSUS DE LIGUORI:

MY JESUS,

I BELIEVE THAT YOU ARE PRESENT IN THE MOST HOLY SACRAMENT,

I LOVE YOU ABOVE ALL THINGS,

AND I DESIRE TO RECEIVE YOU IN TO MY SOUL.

SINCE I CANNOT AT THIS MOMENT RECEIVE YOU SACRAMENTALLY,

COME AT LEAST SPIRITUALLY INTO MY HEART.

I EMBRACE YOU AS IF YOU WERE ALREADY THERE AND UNITE MYSELF WHOLLY TO YOU.

NEVER PERMIT ME TO BE SEPARATED FROM YOU.
