PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONER, IS IT COINCIDENTAL OR PROVIDENTIAL THAT ONE OF THE FIRST MOVIES TO BE SHOWN IN THEATRES SINCE THEIR OPENING DURING THE PANDEMIC IS TITLED, UNHINGED? THEY SAY THAT ART REFLECTS LIFE, AND, MAYBE, THIS MOVIE IS DOING JUST THAT. WITH THE RIOTS IN OUR CITIES, THE LOSS OF CIVILITY, THE INABILITY TO ACCEPT ANOTHER'S OPINIONS AND TO LISTEN TO ONE ANOTHER, OUR FEELING IRRITABLE AND RESTLESS, AND FLYING OFF THE HANDLE AT THE SLIGHTEST PROVOCATION RAISES THE QUESTION AS TO WHETHER WE ARE ALL FEELING UNHINGED; THAT WE'VE ALL GONE OVER THE DEEP EDGE. THIS IS WHEN WE NEED TO GRAB AHOLD OF OURSELVES AND HOLD ON TO OUR CORE VALUES AND PRINCIPLES TO HELP US THROUGH THESE TROUBLED TIMES. THESE VALUES AND PRINCIPALS GIVE US A SENSE OF STABILITY IN MAKING THE RIGHT DECISIONS AND DOING THE GOOD. OUR RELIGIOUS UPBRINGING, OUR PARENTS, OUR SCHOOLING HAVE SHAPED THESE VALUES AND PRINCIPLES. OUR PARENTS HAVE PASSED ON THE FAITH TO US AND THE PRACTICE OF OUR FAITH SHOWS US THAT WE MUST ACCEPT EACH OTHER IN CHARITY WHETHER WE AGREE WITH THAT PERSON OR NOT. WE RESPECT ONE ANOTHER AS CREATED IN THE IMAGE OF GOD. WE LEARN HOW TO FORGIVE EACH OTHER. HOWEVER, WITH SUCH
