SECOND COLLECTION TODAY - SINCE WE WERE NOT ABLE TO HAVE THE GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION DUE TO THE PANDEMIC WE WILL BE TAKING UP THIS COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND, SEPTEMBER 19 & 20 AT ALL THE MASSES. POPE FRANCIS HAS ASKED OUR PARISHES TO SUPPORT THE PONTIFICAL GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION, WHICH HELPS CHRISTIANS IN THE HOLY LAND. YOUR GENEROUS SUPPORT HELPS THE CHURCH MINISTER IN PARISHES, PROVIDE CATHOLIC SCHOOLS AND OFFER RELIGIOUS EDUCATION. THE COLLECTION ALSO HELPS TO PRESERVE THE SACRED SHRINES. THE WARS, UNREST AND INSTABILITY HAVE BEEN ESPECIALLY HARD ON CHRISTIANS. IN THESE TIMES OF CRISIS, THE GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION PROVIDES HUMANITARIAN AID TO REFUGEES. WHEN YOU CONTRIBUTE TO PONTIFICAL GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION, YOU BECOME AN INSTRUMENT OF PEACE AND JOIN WITH CATHOLICS AROUND THE WORLD IN SOLIDARITY WITH THE CHURCH IN THE HOLY LAND.

PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, THE DIOCESE OF COLUMBUS HAS DESIGNATED SEPTEMBER 24, OUR LADY OF MERCY, AS A DAY OF PRAYER, FASTING AND PENANCE. WITH SO MUCH TURMOIL AND UNCERTAINTY IN OUR COUNTRY, WE NEED TO TURN BACK TO OUR LORD WITH ALL OUR HEARTS, MINDS, AND SOULS. I WONDER IF WHAT WE ARE EXPERIENCING IS DUE TO THE NUMBER OF ABORTIONS THAT ARE OCCURRING AND THE MORAL DECLINE IN OUR COUNTRY. THESE ABORTIONS CRY OUT TO GOD FOR RETRIBUTION. WE NEED TO BE PRAYING, FASTING AND DOING PENANCE FOR OUR SINS. IN THE OLD TESTAMENT PEOPLE WOULD PUT ON SACK CLOTH AND SIT IN ASHES. THEY WOULD ALSO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING. WHEN JONAH PROCLAIMED THAT IN FORTY DAYS NINEVEH WOULD BE DESTROYED THE KING DECREE THAT NEITHER MAN NOR CATTLE, NOR SHEEP SHALL EAT ANYTHING OR DRINK ANY WATER AND THEY SHALL BE COVERED WITH SACKCLOTH AND CALL LOUDLY TO THE LORD. WHEN GOD SAW THEM REPENT AND TURN AWAY FROM THEIR EVIL WAY, HE TURNED AWAY FROM THE EVIL HE WAS GOING TO CARRY OUT ON THEM. INTERESTINGLY, JONAH BECAME ANGRY WITH GOD BECAUSE HE DID NOT DESTROY THE CITY; HE KNEW THAT THE LORD IS A GRACIOUS AND MERCIFUL GOD, SLOW TO ANGER, RICH IN CLEMENCY, LOATHE TO PUNISH. THIS STORY BRINGS OUT TWO THINGS; THAT GOD PUNISHES WRONGDOING, AND HE IS WILLING TO FORGIVE THOSE WHO REPENT AND TURN BACK TO HIM. WITH THE RIOTS IN OUR CITIES, WITH THE MURDER RATE GOING UP, THE NUMBER OF LIES BEING TOLD, WE RECOGNIZE OUR NEED FOR REPENTANCE. WE DON'T HAVE TO GO TO THE EXTREME OF SACKCLOTH AND ASHES, BUT WE DO NEED PRAYER, FASTING, AND PENANCE. ON THIS DAY WE SHOULD DECIDE LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF FOOD WE EAT AND MAYBE EVEN GIVE UP ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. IN PLACE OF FOOD AND DRINK WE SHOULD PLACE CHRIST IN OUR HEARTS, MINDS, AND SOULS. TO HELP US IN OUR PRAYER AND PENANCE ON THIS DAY I WILL HAVE A HOLY HOUR FROM 5:30 TO 6:30P.M., AT HOLY TRINITY CHURCH. ALSO, THIS DAY'S MASS WILL FOLLOW THE HOLY HOUR AT 6:30P.M. SO THAT THOSE WHO ARE RETURNING FROM WORK MAY ATTEND. WITH SO MUCH VIOLENCE AND DISRUPTION IN OUR COUNTRY, WE NEED TO TURN BACK TO GOD.
