PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, MY SIBLINGS AND I GATHERED THIS PAST WEEKEND TO HAVE AN ESTATE SALE. ACTUALLY, IT WAS MORE LIKE A GARAGE SALE FOR WE HAD NOT HIRED A PROFESSIONAL COMPANY TO CONDUCT IT. AS WE PREPARED ITEMS FOR THE SALE, WE RAN ACROSS A NUMBER OF MOM'S PERSONAL THINGS WHICH OBVIOUSLY HAD A SPECIAL MEANING FOR HER. WE FOUND A SMALL BOOK ON OUR LADY'S SODALITY WITH SEVERAL COMMUNION BREAKFASTS TICKETS FOR THE YEARS 1940, 41, AND 42. OF COURSE IT RAISED QUESTIONS FOR US WHICH WE NO LONGER COULD GET ANSWERS: WHAT SIGNIFICANCE DID THESE HAVE FOR MOM THAT SHE HAD SAVED THEM, WHAT INFLUENCE DID THEY HAVE ON MOM'S SPIRITUALITY (SHE HAD BEEN THE PRESIDENT OF SODALITY), AND THESE DATES WHICH WERE CLOSE TO HER MARRIAGE IN 1944? THEY REVEALED A PART OF MOM'S LIFE WHICH WE COULD NOT KNOW UNLESS SHE TOLD US. IT SHOWED THAT THERE ARE MORE TO OUR PARENTS THAN JUST BEING MOM AND DAD. THEY HAD THEIR INTERESTS AND PLEASURES WHICH MADE THEM WHO THEY WERE. OH, WE GOT TO KNOW SOMETHING OF THEIR PAST, BUT THERE WAS SO MUCH MORE TO THEM THAN WE COULD HAVE IMAGINED. THESE ARE QUESTIONS WE COULD HAVE PURSUED WHEN WE GOT OLDER AND COULD TALK TO THEM AS ADULTS, BUT NEVER THOUGHT TO ASK BECAUSE WE DID NOT TAKE THE TIME TO KNOW THEM BETTER OR WERE TOO BUSY WITH OUR OWN LIVES. IT IS A LESSON TO LEARN IN ALL OF OUR RELATIONS.
