PARISHIONERS, THIS HAS BEEN A THANKSGIVING LIKE NO OTHER. BUT THEN, 2020 HAS HAD A SURREALIST FEELING ABOUT IT SINCE THE PANDEMIC HIT. SO MANY TRADITIONAL EVENTS HAVE BEEN CANCELLED, POSTPONED, OR MODIFIED. THE MACY'S THANKSGIVING PARADE WAS JUST CLIPS FROM PAST PARADES. HOLY TRINITY SCHOOL'S THANKSGIVING MEAL WAS CANCELLED. OUR CHRISTMAS BAZAAR HAS BEEN SUBSTANTIALLY MODIFIED; ALL OUR FAMILIAR GATHERINGS HAVE BEEN CURTAILED, AND WHO EVER COULD IMAGINE A STATE WIDE CURFEW. ALL MY SENSES ARE REVOLTING AGAINST THIS REALITY, THEY DO NOT WANT TO ACCEPT IT. WE JUST WANT TO GET BACK TO OUR FAMILIAR ROUTINES. HOWEVER, THIS IS NOT TO BE. WE MAY WONDER WHAT WE MUST BE THANKFUL FOR. WHEN WE THINK OF THE PILGRIMS AND THEIR FIRST THANKSGIVING AND HOW THEY WENT THROUGH A VERY BITTER WINTER IN WHICH A NUMBER OF THEM DIED, WE SEE HOW THEY WERE THANKFUL FOR THE BLESSINGS THE LORD HAD GIVEN THEM. MAYBE, WE NEED TO CONSIDER WHAT OPPORTUNITIES OUR PRESENT SITUATION IS GIVING US TO DO SOME INTROSPECTION ABOUT THE MOST IMPORTANT THINGS IN OUR LIVES. WE CAN EASILY RUN AROUND DOING USELESS THINGS OR NOT FACE WHAT WE NEED TO CHANGE. PROBABLY THE BIGGEST THING WE NEED TO BE THANKFUL FOR IS OUR FAMILIES.
