PASTOR'S NOTE

PARISHIONERS, THERE IS SOMETHING RATHER TROUBLESOME HAPPENING IN OUR SOCIETY WHICH HAS THE POTENTIAL TO THREATEN FREEDOM OF SPEECH, EVEN OUR FREEDOM TO EXPRESS OUR RELIGIOUS BELIEFS. WE SEE IT IN PEOPLE BEING BLOCKED FROM SOCIAL MEDIA. THIS WAS ALREADY MANIFESTED WHEN WE SAW COLLEGE STUDENTS SHOUTING DOWN AND REJECTING OTHERS WHO HAD DIFFERENT OPINIONS THAN THEIRS. COLLEGE SHOULD BE A PLACE OF LEARNING WHERE PEOPLE CAN EXPRESS VIEWS THAT ARE NOT POPULAR OR HELD BY OTHERS. IN THE FREE EXCHANGE OF IDEAS PEOPLE WILL RECOGNIZE THE TRUTH AND ACCEPT IT; BUT NOW THERE ARE SOME WHO ARE PROHIBITING ONE SIDE OF THE ISSUE FROM BEING EXPRESSED. WHEN THIS HAPPENS THEN WE CANNOT ADEQUATELY DETERMINE WHAT THE TRUTH IS. THE PROBLEM IS THAT THOSE WHO REJECT OPINIONS THAT THEY DO NOT ACCEPT ARE BECOMING MORE STRIDENT AND AGGRESSIVE IN PROMOTING THEIR BELIEFS. WE SAW IT THIS PAST FRIDAY, JAN. 22, WHEN A SMALL GROUP OF PRO-ABORTIONISTS STORMED ST. JOSEPH CATHEDRAL WHERE BISHOP BRENNAN WAS CELEBRATING A PRO-LIFE MASS. THEY WERE PROCLAIMING THAT THIS CHURCH HATED PEOPLE WITH A MIXTURE OF OBSCENITIES. THEY WERE FORCEFULLY EJECTED, BUT THE FACT IS WE CAN RECOGNIZE THEIR RIGHT TO DO THIS AND REJECT THE RIGHT OF OTHERS TO SAY WHAT THEY THINK IS RIGHT. THE ACCEPTANCE OF SOME TO EXPRESS THEIR VIEWS WHILE REJECTING THE RIGHT FOR OTHERS CAN ONLY LEAD TO A CERTAIN GROUP OF PEOPLE DETERMINING WHAT CAN ONLY BE SAID AND THIS EVENTUALLY LEADS TO THIS SELECT GROUP DICTATING WHAT WE CAN BELIEVE AND PRACTICE. THIS BECOMES A REAL THREAT TO OUR FAITH WHEN WE PROCLAIM TRUTHS THAT GO AGAINST WHAT IS ACCEPTED BY THE POWERS THAT BE, SUCH AS OUR STANCE AGAINST ABORTION. Now, more than ever, we need to be vigilant and stand up for free speech.
