### **PASTOR'S NOTE**

PARISHIONERS, SPIRITUAL WOMEN AND RELIGIOUS SISTERS HAVE WELL SERVED THE DOMINICAN FATHERS AND BROTHERS EVER SINCE THEIR COMING TO SOMERSET. WE NEED ONLY TO THINK OF THE SISTERS WHO TOOK SUCH GOOD CARE OF THE NOVICES AND STUDENTS WHEN THE PRIORY WAS HERE. WE NOW HAVE DOMINICAN NUNS WHO ARE LOOKING TO BUILD ON ST. JOSEPH'S PROPERTY. THESE NUNS ARE FROM BUFFALO, NEW YORK. BISHOP BRENNAN HAS MADE A BIG PUSH TO BRING SISTERS AND NUNS INTO THE COLUMBUS DIOCESE. HE HAS RECOGNIZED THE IMPORTANT WORK THAT THE SISTERS DO AND THE POWER OF PRAYER THAT THE NUNS PROVIDE. MY UNDERSTANDING IS THAT URBAN DEVELOPMENT AROUND THEIR MONASTERY IN BUFFALO WAS BECOMING DISRUPTIVE TO THEIR CONTEMPLATIVE LIFE SO THEY ACCEPTED BISHOP BRENNAN'S INVITATION TO MOVE TO COLUMBUS. THEY HAVE BEEN STAYING AT THE STS. PETER AND PAUL RETREAT HOUSE (THE OLD PIME SEMINARY). THE BISHOP SHOWED THE NUNS SEVERAL SITES THEY MIGHT CONSIDER BUILDING ON. HE ALSO SHOWED THEM OUR PROPERTY. WELL, AFTER MUCH DELIBERATION, THE NUNS DECIDED THAT THEY WOULD LIKE TO BUILD ON OUR PROPERTY. THEY ARE ASKING TO PURCHASE 50.44 ACRES WHICH INCLUDES THE LAND SOUTH OF THE DRIVEWAY GOING UP TO THE UPPER PARKING LOT OF ST. JOSEPH, THE EASTERN BORDER ALONG OLD SOMERSET ROAD TO TOWNSHIP ROAD 122 AND THEN TO LAKE ST. JOSEPH BOUNDARY. NUNS ARE DIFFERENT THAN SISTERS. NUNS LIVE IN A CLOISTER WHICH IS USUALLY CALLED A MONASTERY AND DO NOT OFTEN LEAVE IT; THEY ARE OFTEN IN PRAYER AND CONTEMPLATION, WHEREAS SISTERS GO OUT OF THE CONVENT TO BE ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THE WORLD. THE NUNS' PRESENCE AMONG US OFFERS A WONDERFUL HELP THROUGH THEIR PRAYERS FOR US AND OTHERS.
