Sacrament of Marriage

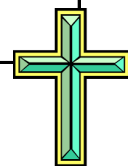
Arrangements with a Priest required at least one year prior to the wedding date.

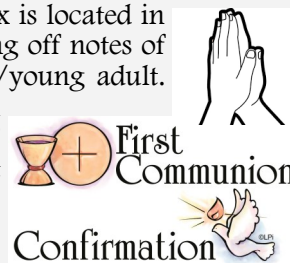
CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD: "Children's Liturgy of the

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD



THE BAPTISM OF CHRIST is a famous painting by Leonardo da Vinci's master, Andrea del Verrochio at circa 1472 in his studio in Italy. The painting was completed by Verrochio in collaboration with his apprentice, Leonardo da Vinci who painted and finished the details of some parts of the painting, particularly the angel. The painting was an altarpiece commissioned by the monks of the San Salvi Church near Florence.

“John answered them all, *‘I baptize you with water; but he who is mightier than I is coming...he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit...’*” (Luke 3:16) The Catholic Catechism states that “Jesus’ immersion in the water is a sign for all human beings of the need to die to themselves to do God’s will.” In other words, as baptized Catholics there is only one gift that we need to give to Jesus – the gift of ourselves. Surrender yourself to God, place your trust in Him and allow the Holy Spirit to work through you for the greater glory of God.
