Dear Parents,

Our records indicate that you have a child in the second grade or above who will be eligible to be prepared for the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. If you want to have your child prepared for the sacraments at this time, please plan to attend an informational parent meeting via Zoom on either Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm or Tuesday, September 29<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm. Enclosed with this letter is the registration form, medical treatment release form and a tentative schedule of classes. During the meeting we will discuss other information concerning our expectations for the sacramental preparation process. I will also answer any questions you may have about our process here at Saint John Fisher. The classes will begin on October 18, 2020.

There are several questions on the registration form about your preferences for either on-line or in-person classes. Depending upon your responses and the Covid-19 restrictions at the time classes begin, we will determine the format of the classes and let you know how we will proceed.

**We will need an original copy (with the church seal and pastor's signature) of your child's Baptismal Certificate** (if your child was *not* Baptized at St. John Fisher). We will make a copy of the certificate and return it to you. Please return the completed forms to the office, by snail mail, email (except Baptismal Certificate copy), or in the offertory baskets by Sunday, September 13, 2020.
