

GENITIVE ADJECTIVES

Adjectives work exactly like us-nouns, a-nouns, and um-nouns. So adjectives matching a genitive noun will have the same endings as us-nouns, a-nouns, and um-nouns in the genitive case, as follows:

-us -a -um adjectives

Consider the following examples:

*Panis viri **magni*** ("the large man's bread")

*Canistrum plenum caseorum **magnorum*** ("basket full of large cheeses")
