GUIDELINES

An Agape Event shall be held biennially within each Metropolis Conference. The Vicar of the respective conference will select the Philoptochos Chapter and location.

Upon recommendation from the Conference Vicar, the Metropolitan shall appoint a Host Parish Priest to serve as Chair of the Event from each conference. The Metropolis Philoptochos President shall appoint a Co-chair to be the Host Philoptochos Representative from each conference.

The Vicar and Co-chair Philoptochos Representative will coordinate the first meeting with each of the Conference Parish Priests and Chapter Philoptochos Presidents to determine the Agape Event Program, Date, Time and Place.

All meetings will be called, as needed, by the Conference Vicar with reports submitted to the Metropolitan and Metropolis Philoptochos President for review, advisement and final approval.

Following the Agape Event, the local Chapter should keep 25% of the net profit for their Chapter. The Chapter should mail the remaining 75% of the net proceeds to the Metropolis Philoptochos Treasurer. The Philoptochos Treasurer will transfer the money to the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of Atlanta.
