Message from our Pastor

In today's gospel, Jesus describes how his disciples should appear and act, as He allows them to begin sharing in his ministry of exorcisms, healing, and preaching.

EXEGESIS:

Jesus presents a model for missionary activity for his disciples and begins sharing teaching and healing power with them. "Only a walking stick" would enable them to defend themselves against road robbers and wild animals. "No sack, no money in belt" would prevent them from seeking excessive donations and becoming bloated with money. "Wear not a second tunic" as a sign of poverty. The disciples are to depend on others for food and shelter. "Shake the dust from your feet" symbolizes removing the hardhearted non-believers from their preaching agenda, and also indicates taking non-violent, not violent, protest against them. The disciples preach Jesus' message of repentance in light of God's kingdom, and they use oil as a healing tool, something common in those days.
