The exhibition will run through April 3. The history of the Crusader Bible covers seven centuries and multiple continents. Likely created in Paris during the 1240s for King Louis IX of France -- famous for building the Sainte-Chapelle and for leading two crusades -- the Bible then passed to the king's younger brother, Charles of Anjou, who took it to Italy.
