**St. Patrick's Day (Friday, March 17) a Dispensation:** Bishop Joe Vásquez has received several requests for dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat on St. Patrick's Day which falls on a Friday this year. Taking into consideration the Irish Catholic population in the Diocese of Austin, Bishop Vásquez grants a dispensation for all Catholics in the Diocese. If the dispensation is taken Bishop Vasquez asks that the individual do an act of charity or penance on another day.

**Special collection next weekend:** The Catholic Relief Services Collection supports Catholic Church organizations that carry out international relief and solidarity efforts. Programs include relief and resettlement for victims of persecution, war, and natural disasters; development projects to improve living conditions for the poor; legal and support services for poor immigrants; peace and reconciliation work for people suffering from violence; and advocacy on behalf of the powerless.

**From Ashes to Easter:** Each family is invited to pick up a box and keep it on or near the family dining table or by their bedside table. Put in some coins each day during Lent, and pray for missions worldwide.
