<p>32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time The first reading today is the moving story of Jewish martyrs willing to die for their faith rather than break the dietary laws of their faith. What are we willing to sacrifice for others? The principles of Catholic Social Teaching cover everything from human life to the environment. They teach us about care for the poor and vulnerable, the importance of family; the importance of solidarity.
