If another Priest/Deacon is being asked to have the service, please check with the Pastor first.

The viewing of the body is done at the funeral home and if necessary at Church, before Mass.

Viewing the body after Mass disrupts the continuation of the Liturgy, which ends at the cemetery. It also deprives the priest of escorting the body to the funeral coach.
