Sacrament of Marriage

Call at least six months to one year in advance for information. All couples are required by the Diocese of Amarillo to attend Engaged Encounter and Natural Family Planning. After the couple has met the requirements of the Diocese, they meet with Priest to discuss the Pastoral Guidelines for Marriage, to plan the wedding, and to set the date.

Sacrament of Penance

Every Saturday from 5.30 p.m. – 6.00 p.m. or by appointment. Communal reconciliation with individual confessions during Advent and Lent.

Marian Devotions:

May is a month for Mary. In this month, learn more about a new Marian devotion. Mary Untier / Undoer of Knots: Pope Francis is well known in Argentina and Brazil for promoting devotion to Our Lady Undoer of Knots which has been a source of healing and grace for countless families. The devotion to Mary Undoer of Knots (also known as Mary Untier of Knots) is becoming more and more known in many different countries.

The first reference to for Our Lady as Untier of Knots is attributed to St. Irenaeus. Saint Irenaeus made a comparison between Eve and Mary, saying, "Eve, by her disobedience, tied the knot of disgrace for the human race; whereas Mary, by her obedience, undid it". The modern representation of Mary undoing the knots of sin and disobedience is a painting dating to 17th century Germany. For centuries, devotion to Mary under this title "Undoer of Knots" was localized to Germany. The devotion spread into South America aided by one of the Novena's chief promoters Pope Francis. In the 1980's, the then Fr. Jorge Bergoglio, was in Germany to finish his doctoral studies. He visited the church of St. Peter am Perlach and came across the original painting "Our Lady Untier of Knots" by Johann Melchior Georg Schmittner. He was struck by the painting and the devotion. He brought a copy of the painting and the devotion back with him to Argentina, and promoted it under this name. Through Fr. Bergoglio Argentine Catholics came to know about this German devotion. Around this same time the Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant disaster in Ukraine occurred and as a result the devotion spread across Europe. Victims sought intercession from Mary and eventually the first chapel dedicated to 'Mary Untier of Knots' was built in Styria, Austria in 1989.

The image of Mary Untier of Knots at the main altar of the chapel was created by painter Franz Weiss. It differed from the original, because the artist took as his theme the Chernobyl tragedy. Currently there is not one solitary "official" church designated novena nor has one been given by divine revelation. Most Novenas under this title were composed by lay people in Brazil and Argentina and given to the whole Church in its ministry of healing. This Novena is traditionally used to seek Mary's intercession and resolution in marital and family situations where there appears to be not clear solution.
