Pope Francis to marriages: Trust and learn from the Immaculate Virgin Mary



“In the greetings he addressed this morning to the faithful present at the General Audience, Pope Francis encouraged marriages to follow the example of trust and obedience of the Virgin Mary, whose Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is celebrated on Saturday, December 8.

Next Saturday we will celebrate the solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Let's entrust ourselves to Our Lady! She, as a model of faith and obedience to the Lord, helps us prepare our hearts to receive the Child Jesus in his Nativity, "said the Holy Father in his words addressed to newlyweds, the sick and the elderly.

The Pope also encouraged marriages arrived from Croatia, which on Tuesday December 4 renewed their "wedding vows in the Basilica of St. Peter, confessing that the Lord has helped them in the happy and sad moments of life."

"I encourage you to live conjugal love, a sign of love between Christ and the Church, daily deepening the mutual surrender in small gestures," encouraged the Pontiff.

"In this time of Advent, the Blessed Virgin Mary is for you an example of how to receive the Lord and trust in him. Praised be Jesus and Mary!", Concluded Francisco.

During the General Audience this Wednesday in the Paul VI Hall in the Vatican, the Holy Father began a cycle of catechesis on the Our Father, which began with the theme "Teach us to pray."
