Pope Francis invites us to rediscover the grace of the Sacrament of Baptism:



VATICAN: In his message in Italian during the General Audience on January 9 at the Vatican, Pope Francis invited "to rediscover the grace of the sacrament of our Baptism. The Holy Father recalled this weekend Sunday January 13 "we will celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord" which is the celebration that concludes the liturgical season of Christmas. The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord "invites us to rediscover the grace of the sacrament of our Baptism", said the Pope, and assured that Baptism "has made us Christians, incorporating ourselves to Christ and his Church".For this reason, the Pontiff encouraged "to thank the Lord for the gift of faith"

And to ask the Holy Spirit for "the Strength to be courageous witnesses of Jesus.

"In addition, the Pope invited us to remember the date on which we were baptized and celebrate that day. "All of us know the date of our birth. But not everyone knows the date of Baptism, which is the birth to the life of the Church, when the Holy Spirit comes to the heart, "he explained."That's why I ask you today, for example, to prepare for the party on Sunday, ask, who know, remember, and who do not know the date of his Baptism, ask family members, godparents, parents , to grandparents, when was I born to the life of faith ?, that is, when was I baptized? And always fix in the heart the date of Baptism ... It is very important to celebrate the date of Baptism! "He exclaimed.

As is tradition, the Holy Father will celebrate the Mass this Sunday, the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, in the Sistine Chapel. During the Eucharist the Holy Father will preside over the rite of Baptism of some children, children of Vatican employees.

El Papa Francisco invita a redescubrir la gracia del Sacramento del Bautismo:



VATICANO: En su mensaje en italiano durante la Audiencia General del 9 de enero en el Vaticano, el Papa Francisco invitó a “redescubrir la gracia del sacramento de nuestro Bautismo”. El Santo Padre recordó que este fin de semana domingo 13 de enero “celebraremos la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor” que es la celebración que concluye el tiempo litúrgico de la Navidad. La Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor “nos invita a redescubrir la gracia del sacramento de nuestro Bautismo”, dijo el Papa, y aseguró que el Bautismo “nos ha hecho cristianos, incorporándonos a Cristo y a su Iglesia”. Porello, el Pontífice animó a “agradecer al Señor por el don de la fe” y a pedir al Espíritu Santo “la fuerza de ser valientes testigos de Jesús”.

Además, el Papa invitó a recordar la fecha en que fuimos bautizados y festejamos. “Todos nosotros sabemos la fecha de nuestro nacimiento. Pero no todos saben la fecha del Bautismo, que es el nacimiento a la vida de la Iglesia, cuando el Espíritu Santo viene al corazón”, explicó. “Por eso yo les pido hoy, por ejemplo, para prepararnos a la fiesta del domingo este fin de semana, preguntar —quienes lo saben, recordarlo— y quienes no saben la fecha de su Bautismo, preguntar a los familiares, a los padrinos, a los padres, a los abuelos, ¿cuándo nací a la vida de la fe?, es decir, ¿cuándo fui bautizado? Y fijar siempre en el corazón la fecha del Bautismo... ¡Es muy importante festejar la fecha del Bautismo!”, exclamó.

Como tradición, el Santo Padre celebrará la Misa el este fin de semana domingo, fiesta del Bautismo del Señor, en la Capilla Sixtina. Durante la Eucaristía el Santo Padre presidirá el rito del Bautismo de algunos niños, hijos de empleados vaticanos.
