Pope Francis says Panama to be 'a hub of hope' during World Youth Day



Panama City, Panama, Jan 24, 2019 / 08:55 am (CNA).- Upon arriving in Panama for World Youth Day 2019, Pope Francis met with politicians, diplomats and civil society leaders, extending a message of hope for “a more humane world.”

“In these days, Panama ... will turn into a hub of hope,” Pope Francis told leaders gathered outside Panama City’s Bolivar Palace Jan. 24.

“Young people demand a commitment in which all – beginning with those of us who call ourselves Christians – have the audacity to build an authentically human politics that makes the person the centre and heart of everything,” he said

In his first public appearance since his arrival in Panama, Pope Francis emphasized that “it is possible to defend the common good above the interests of a few or for few only when there is a firm decision to share with justice one’s goods.”

“The younger generation, with its joy and enthusiasm, with its freedom, sensitivity and critical capacity, demands that adults, and especially all those who exercise roles of leadership in public life, lead a life consonant with the dignity and authority that they possess and that has been entrusted to them,” he said.

“By welcoming the dreams of these young people, Panama becomes once more a land of dreams that challenges so many certainties of our time and opens up vital horizons that can enrich the path ahead through a respectful and compassionate gaze upon others,” Pope Francis said.

## Homilía Del Tercer Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario

### La Buena Nueva Nos Libera

Hoy, el tercer domingo del tiempo ordinario, nos alegremos en la buena nueva de la salvación que Cristo nos trae. Esta buena nueva nos une como un pueblo de Dios y nos permite trabajar y caminar juntos por el reino de Dios.

En nuestra primera lectura, después de que el pueblo había trabajado junto para alcanzar su objetivo y su libertad, Nehemías los reunió y los leyó la buena nueva. Después de escuchar y meditar sobre la palabra de Dios, el pueblo resonó “¡Amén!”

En el Evangelio de hoy, Lucas narra su propio “cuenta sólido y ordenado” de los acontecimientos sobre Cristo. Su audiencia es “Teófilo”. Este nombre griego simplemente significa “amante o buscador de Dios”. Históricamente hablando, se cree popularmente que Teófilo simplemente se refiere a todos los que aman o buscan a Dios. Por lo tanto, esta buena nueva es para todos nosotros que aman a Dios sinceramente.

Hoy, Jesús presenta su misión. Esto es, el cumplimiento de la profecía de Isaías 61: *“El espíritu del Señor está sobre mí, porque me ha ungido para llevar a los pobres la buena nueva, para anunciar la liberación a los cautivos y la curación a los ciegos, para dar libertad a los oprimidos y proclamar el año de gracia del Señor.* Esta profecía se hizo cuando los israelitas vivían en la esclavitud y la miseria en el exilio.

- Blessing of Throats Feast of Saint Blasé Feb 2nd & 3rd, 2019 Suffering and illness have always been among the greatest problems that trouble the human spirit. Christians feel and experience pain as do all other people; yet their faith helps them to grasp more deeply the mystery of suffering and to bear their pain with greater courage...Part of the plan laid out by God's providence is that we should fight strenuously against all sickness and carefully seek the blessings of good health, so that we may fulfill our role in human society and in the ancient customs, rooted in imitation of Christ himself and his apostles. In the United States the annual blessing of throats is ordinarily given during Mass or a celebration of the world of God on February 3rd, the memorial of Saint Blasé. Saint Blasé was the Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. Very little is know about his life.
