Liturgy is not 'styles, recipes, trends,' pope tells Divine Worship congregation



Vatican City, Feb 14, 2019 (CNA/EWTN News).- The liturgy, Pope Francis said Thursday, cannot be reduced to a matter of taste, becoming the subject of ideological polarization, because it is a primary way Catholics encounter the Lord.

He also recalled his statement in *Evangeliigaudium* “that reality is more important than the idea.”

Meeting the congregation during their, Pope Francis addressed the importance of the Church’s liturgy. Francis said. “You therefore have before you a great and beautiful task: to work so that the People of God rediscovers the beauty of meeting the Lord in the celebration of his mysteries.” He argued that proper liturgical formation of both clergy and laity is fundamental, and quoted from *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, the Second Vatican Council’s 1963 constitution on the sacred liturgy.

Though necessary, just providing information about liturgical books is not an adequate liturgical education, he continued, even with a view toward preserving the dutiful fulfillment of the ritual disciplines. “In order for the liturgy to fulfill its formative and transforming function, it is necessary that pastors and the laity be brought to grasp its meaning and symbolic language, including art, song and music at the service of the celebrated mystery, even silence,” he stated.

He pointed to mystagogy as a suitable way to enter into the mystery of the liturgy, “in the living encounter with the crucified and risen Lord”; he pointed to the Catechism of the Catholic Church as an example of a book that illustrates the liturgy in this manner. “To speak of the liturgical formation of the People of God means first of all to become aware of the irreplaceable role that the liturgy plays in the Church and for the Church,” he stated. “And then concretely help the People of God to better internalize the prayer of the Church, to love it as an experience of meeting with the Lord and with the brothers and, in light of this, to rediscover its contents and observe its rites.”

Papa Francisco: La liturgia es un tesoro que no puedereducirse a gustos o corrientes



La liturgia sagrada es “un tesoro vivo que no puedereducirse a gustos, recetas y corrientes”, señaló el Papa Francisco durante la audiencia que concedió a la Asamblea Plenaria de la Congregación para el Culto Divino y la Disciplina de los Sacramentos este 14 de febrero, donde también dijo que “para que la vida sea verdaderamente una alabanza agradable a Dios, es ciertamente necesario cambiar el corazón”.

El Santo Padre recordó que la asamblea de este año tiene por tema “La formación litúrgica del Pueblo de Dios” y dijo que “en efecto, la tarea que nos espera es esencialmente difundir en el Pueblo de Dios el esplendor del misterio vivo del Señor, manifestado en la liturgia”.

“Hablar de formación litúrgica del Pueblo de Dios significa, ante todo, tomar conciencia del papel insustituible que desempeña la liturgia en la Iglesia y para la Iglesia. Y luego, ayudar concretamente al Pueblo de Dios a interiorizar mejor la oración de la Iglesia, a amarla como una experiencia de encuentro con el Señor y con los hermanos y, a la luz de esto, a redescubrir su contenido y observar sus ritos”, explicó el Papa

De este modo, el Pontífice reconoció que “no basta con cambiar los libros litúrgicos para mejorar la calidad de la liturgia. Hacer esto solamente sería un engaño” sino que “para que la vida sea verdaderamente una alabanza agradable a Dios, es ciertamente necesario cambiar el corazón”.
