1. Why pray to Mary at all? Because God wills that we should do so, and because such prayers to her are of the utmost value. God often will to give certain favors only on condition that we go to some secondary agent. Sodom was to be spared through the intercession of Abraham; Naaman, the leper was to be cured only through the waters of the Jordan. Now Mary is, and must ever remain the mother of the Christ. She still has a mother's rights and privileges, and is able to obtain for us many graces. But let us view things reasonably. If I desire to pray, I can certainly pray to God directly. Yet would you blame me if, at times, I were to ask my own earthly mother to pray for me also? Such a request is really a prayer to her that she may intercede for me with God. Certainly if I met the mother of Christ on earth, I would ask her to pray for me, and she would do so. In her more perfect state with Christ in heaven she is not less able to help me.

2. If the goal of the Christian life is to grow closer to Jesus, why so much focus on His Mother? Does the Rosary really help us grow closer to Jesus? "When the Church looks for Jesus she always knocks at His Mother's door." We are called to do the same.

No one knows our Lord Jesus better than His Mother. No one loves Him more than she. St. John Eudes, St. Louis de Montfort and so many others teach us that the Mother and Son are inseparable. Wherever there is Mary, there is Jesus. Wherever there is Jesus, there is Mary. We cannot come close to Mary without her bringing us, always and immediately, to her Son. Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta used to say, in her simple yet profound way, "No Mary, no Jesus. Know Mary, know Jesus."

3. Why you should say the Rosary Daily: Our Lady has 117 titles. She selected this title at Fatima: "I am the Lady of the Rosary. St. Francis de Sales said the greatest method of praying is Pray the Rosary. St. Thomas Aquinas preached 40 straight days in Rome Italy on just the Hail Mary. St. Padre Pio called the rosary "My Weapon", and usually had a rosary in his hand at all times. St. Bartolo Longo was a Satanist who became a saint after rejecting the devil, by promoting the Holy Rosary. Europe was saved from being taken over by the Muslim Turks at the Battle of Lepanto, after the Pope told his outnumbered forces to pray the Holy Rosary before the battle. St. John Vianney, patron of priests, was seldom seen without a rosary in hand.

1st Native-born US martyr to have shrine in Oklahoma

Blessed Stanley Rother, the first native-born US martyr, will be honored with a shrine in his native Oklahoma. Groundbreaking for the Oklahoma City facility will be November 3.

“The groundbreaking for the shrine will be a significant moment in the life of the Church in Oklahoma and for the broader community,” said Archbishop Paul Coakley of Oklahoma City. “The shrine is being built to honor Blessed Stanley Rother, an Oklahoma original and the first U.S.-born priest and martyr ever beatified. It will be a place of pilgrimage where the faithful will come from near and far to honor

Blessed Stanley at his final resting place and to seek his intercession for their many needs. It will be a place of welcome, serving all people. Described as an “ordinary” priest, Stanley Rother was officially recognized in 2017 as the first martyr of the Catholic Church born in the United States. His beatification drew a crowd of 15,000 in Oklahoma City. and now many will be celebrating his feast day on July 28 each year. According to Maria Ruiz Scaperlanda, his biographer, “He was a farmer from Okarche, Oklahoma, who served the Church as a devoted priest both here and in the Oklahoma mission in Santiago Atitlán — where he literally farmed the Guatemalan fields side by side with his parishioners.” His name was eventually put on a “death list” in Guatemala for his missionary activities, and he was gunned down by militants at the age of 46. The shrine will include a 2,000-seat church, a chapel where Blessed Stanley will be buried, an education building, an event space and several areas designated for shrines and devotion. The site will be developed over time.

- Along with the Spanish colonial-style church – which will be the largest Catholic Church in Oklahoma – an additional element will be a museum and pilgrim center. The center will welcome thousands of visitors each year to an experience that leads them through the life, witness, and martyrdom of Blessed Stanley. The church will host many large diocesan events and will help accommodate the growing Hispanic population, which has left various area parishes significantly overcrowded.
