

CARNIVAL RIDES

For reasons of safety and liability the diocese strongly discourages carnival rides in conjunction with parish or school activities. However, if a parish/school chooses to have carnival rides the following documentation will be submitted to the Office of Insurance at least one week prior to the event:

The parish or school will provide to the Office of Insurance a Certificate of Insurance naming the diocese and parish or school as additional insured from the vendor. Minimum levels of insurances are as follows:

General Liability Insurance:

General Aggregate	\$2,000,000
Products and Completed Operations	\$1,000,000
Personal and Advertising Injury	\$1,000,000
Each Occurrence	\$1,000,000
Fire Damage	\$1,000,000

Excess Liability:

Each Occurrence	\$2,000,000
Aggregate	\$2,000,000

The Office of Insurance will provide the parish or school with a Hold Harmless Agreement. The vendor should complete the form and the parish or school should submit the completed form the Office of Insurance. The purpose of this agreement is to release the parish or school and the diocese from any liability arising as a result of an accident from a carnival ride.

The parish or school should submit a list of the rides to the Office of Insurance prior to the event.
