

FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR DIOCESAN PRIESTS

- I. Diocesan priests will have a copy of their most current will on file in the chancery.
- II. Diocesan priests are encouraged to name the diocese as beneficiary of their diocesan life insurance policy.
- III. Form A provides a sample obituary. Each diocesan priest is asked to review the form and personalize it as appropriate. Once completed the form should be sent to the chancery.
- IV. Each diocesan priest is asked to document his preferences concerning his funeral mass. This should include scripture, celebrant(s) and music, etc.
- V. It is also requested that the priest identify significant people to be acknowledged or participate in the funeral and arrangements.

The chancery will ask priests to review their obituary and will on an annual basis
