The Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) was founded by the U.S. bishops to promote Catholic social teaching and to fund organizations with grants that help people help themselves, to promote human life and dignity, to advance justice and address the root causes of poverty.

A local example of a grant is the **Life to Justice Initiative** representing the Catholic principles of life and justice in a concrete way. The grant to Catholic Community Services is promoting **PREPARES** – a program to create the capacity within every *parish* to provide pregnancy and parenting support resources for mothers, fathers, and children up to age five. **PREPARES'** mission is to provide low-income families with resources, services and referrals resulting in healthy birth outcomes and committed, knowledgeable parents. Additionally, the grant is connecting **PREPARES** to two separate initiatives to assist the Farm Worker and African American communities regarding their economic development.

CCHD grants and education programs, implemented in collaboration with local (arch)bishops, are supported by this annual collection.
